

April 2008 Minutes

The Town Board of Holland met Monday April 7, 2008 at the Town Hall at 8pm.
All members were present.
Chairman Wall called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The first item on the agenda was the review of the Blanket Insurance Policy. Kevin Schromer, agent, was asked to increase the coverage on the Ball Park Policy. Chairman Wall stated that the replacement cost of a light pole, light and labor was around \$9000. It was decided to raise the coverage. Supervisor Geiger made the motion to approve; Seconded by Chairman Wall.
Motion passed.

The second item was a request by a resident for an answer regarding why a sex offender was living in Hollandtown. Chairman Wall stated that Brown County Town's Association was working on a draft ordinance. He stated there would be a hearing on Wednesday, April 16, at 8pm. The public would be invited to attend and suggestions would be considered at this time. It was also stated that this person has served his sentence and no longer has to report to local officials, only the State of Wisconsin.

Next was the discussion of the Windmill Ordinance. Attorney Sickel said that he has an Ordinance that the Town Planning Commission could look at. A motion by Supervisor Geiger to set May 23 at 2pm for the Planning Board to meet and review the Ordinance, with public input, was made. Supervisor VandeWettering made the seconding motion.

Motion passed.

Interested parties from the public stated the windmill companies were in the process of signing up landowners.

The bills were presented and reviewed. A question came up regarding the Vet bill for the cat charge. It was explained that the cat had to be under observation for rabies for 10 days and then destroyed. A motion by Supervisor VandeWettering to approve the bills was made, seconded by Supervisor Geiger.
Motion passed.

There being no other business, a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Supervisor VandeWettering and seconded by Supervisor Geiger.
