

October 2004 Minutes

The Town Board of Holland met on October 4th at 8pm for it

1. The board reviewed the plat of Holland Heights II. After discussion, a motion to approve was made by Sup. Geiger. Seconded by Sup. Brick, Motion passed.
2. The Chairman reported that Farrell Rd. was completed and the job was satisfactory.
3. The retention pond for the Brookside Edition was discussed but there has been no update on any progress. The board would like Atty. Sickle to contact the developer and engineer and make it clear the board would like option 3, the most viable, and no. 2 at his own expense, a motion to that effect was made by Sup. Brick, and seconded by sup. Geiger. Motion passed.
4. A motion to resubmit the resolution to the DNR for the Recycling Grant was made by Sup. Brick, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.
5. The bills were presented and approved; a motion to approve was made by Sup. Brick and seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed. The Ag Extension asked for a \$200 fee for the control of loose leaf strife and Gypsy Moth. A motion was made by Sup. Geiger to approve, seconded by Sup. Brick. Motion passed.
6. The Chairman informed the board of a meeting at the Wrightstown High School, on October 12, regarding the future needs of the district. It is also the same night the town has their Smart Growth meeting and it would not be possible to go.
7. Chairman Wall informed the board that WE Energies was ready to install lights in the new subdivision and the board just had to give the go ahead. A motion in support was given by Sup. Brick, seconded by Sup. Geiger. Motion passed.

The minutes for the Aug., Sept., and the two special meetings in the Sanitary District were read. A motion to approve was made by Sup. Geiger, seconded by Sup Brick. Motion passed.
