

We welcome any exhibitor to demonstrate their craft. Please call or write for permission so that proper arrangements can be made for you. Announcements will be made periodically to call attention to your demonstrations.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. Booth spaces are allotted on FIRST COME – FIRST SERVED basis. The envelope postmark will be the determining factor for all mailed applications.
2. No claim may be made by speech, sign or literature that honey or other hive related products are a cure for any serious medical condition. General statements about the healthfulness of honey and hive products, accurate information about their nutritional qualities, and information about their use in home remedies are acceptable.
3. Items displayed or sold at the Festival shall not, in any way, allude to pornography or be intended for the use or sale of amphetamines or intoxicants. Also should no item fall into any other classification that would not be in keeping with a wholesome, family-type activity. The decision of the Honey Festival Committee will determine the eligibility of questionable items. Any items that are determined to be detrimental to the intent of the Honey Festival shall be immediately removed from sale or display. There shall not be orders taken for any such items to be delivered at a later date. Any exhibitor failing to abide by the decision of the Honey Festival Committee concerning such items shall be asked to remove themselves and their products from the Festival grounds and forfeit their booth fee.
4. An Art or Craft booth consists of items that are handmade or constructed by you and/or your partner, i.e. handmade ceramics, flower arrangements, woodcrafts, etc. A Commercial booth consists of manufactured items purchased by you for resale, but which are not altered or personalized by you, i.e. items produced or packaged under a commercial label or items produced or packaged by anyone other than yourself.
5. The Honey Festival Committee requests that homemade cookies, breads, etc. entered as crafts contain honey. All edible items are subject to the Wood County Health Department requirements for bake sales. An exhibitor wishing to sell edible items as their only product will be classified as a food vendor and will be subject to all rules pertaining to food vendors accepted by the Honey Festival.
6. You may set up your booth any time after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, the day before the Festival. Any exhibitor needing to set up before this time must call for permission to do so. All displays must be set up and ready for the opening of the Festival on Saturday. The Festival hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. Exhibitors need to be at their booth a half-hour before the Festival starting time each morning. Please do not disassemble your booth prior to 5:30 p.m. on Sunday as this detracts from the overall appearance of the Festival.

7. An attractive sign should identify your booth. Your table should be covered on the front and sides. You must provide your own tables and chairs.
8. Electricity will be provided at no additional charge. This is supplied for display purposed only. An outlet box will be located close to your booth, but will not be run directly to you. You are responsible for supplying your own UL approved extension cord.
9. Deadline for entries is August 1. Late entries will be accepted; however, they will be charged an additional \$5.00. This additional fee will be collected at the festival from those who do not include it with their application.
10. Cancellations must be made before September 1 to have their booth fee refunded. After that date, the fee will be forfeited.
11. Night security will be provided for all exhibitors in locations that cannot be secured by locked doors or gates. (The Honey Festival Steering Committee, Festival Sponsors, and the Security Service cannot assume responsibility for damage and /or theft).
12. Exhibitors will be provided a badge to identify you to the gatekeepers and enable you to enter and leave the gates at any time during the Festival without being charged. These MUST be worn at all times during the Festival.

A gift basket of honey related items will be given from the Honey Festival Committee as a prize to the exhibitor with the most attractive or most unique booth display

For safety and health reasons pets or other animals will not be allowed on the Festival Grounds

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN TABLES AND CHAIRS

ALL PLACEMENT IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HONEY FESTIVAL COMMITTEE

ALL SPACES ARE ALLOTTED ON A FIRST-COME FIRST-SERVED BASIS

EXHIBITOR BADGES WILL BE PROVIDED AND MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES
