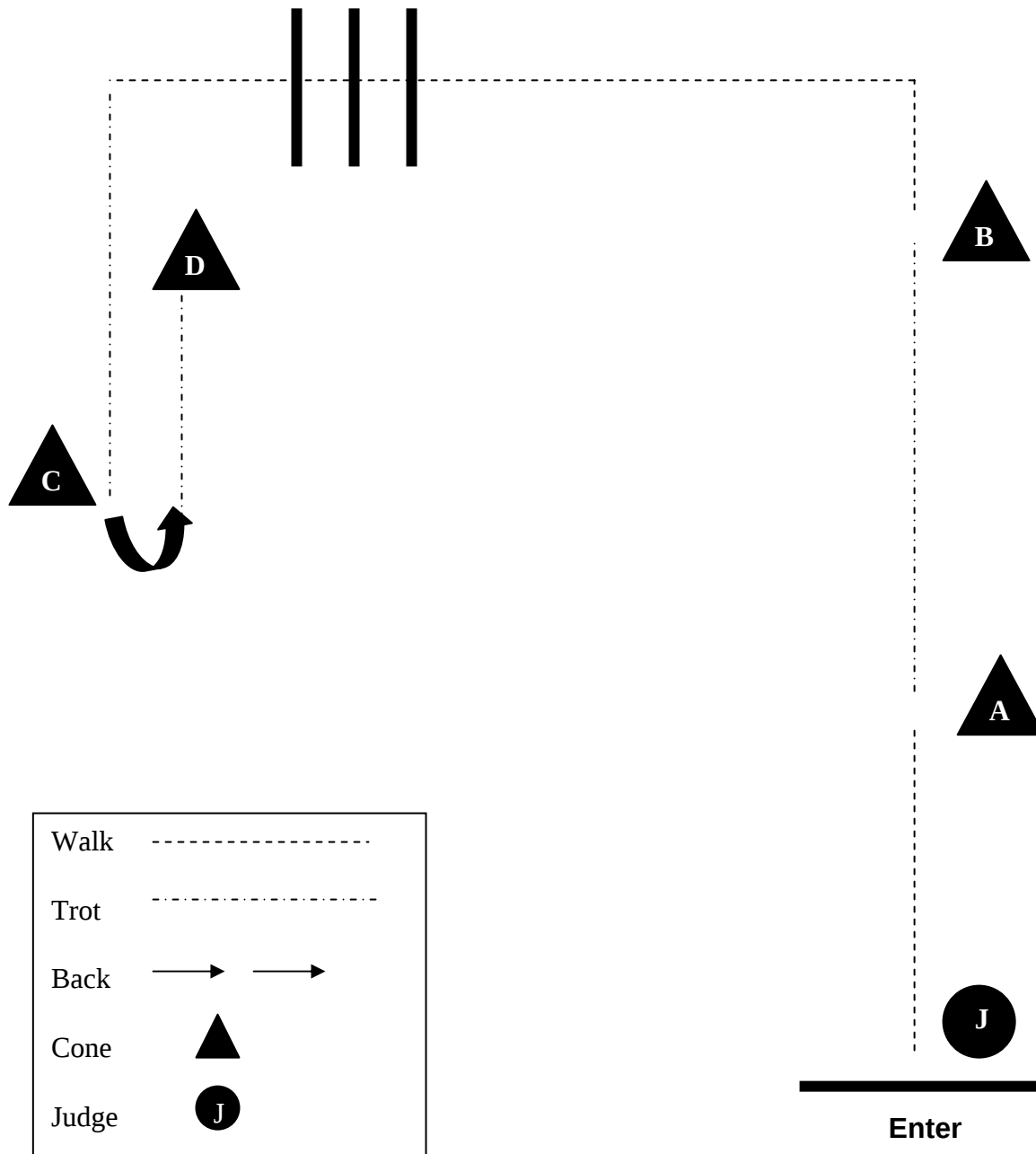


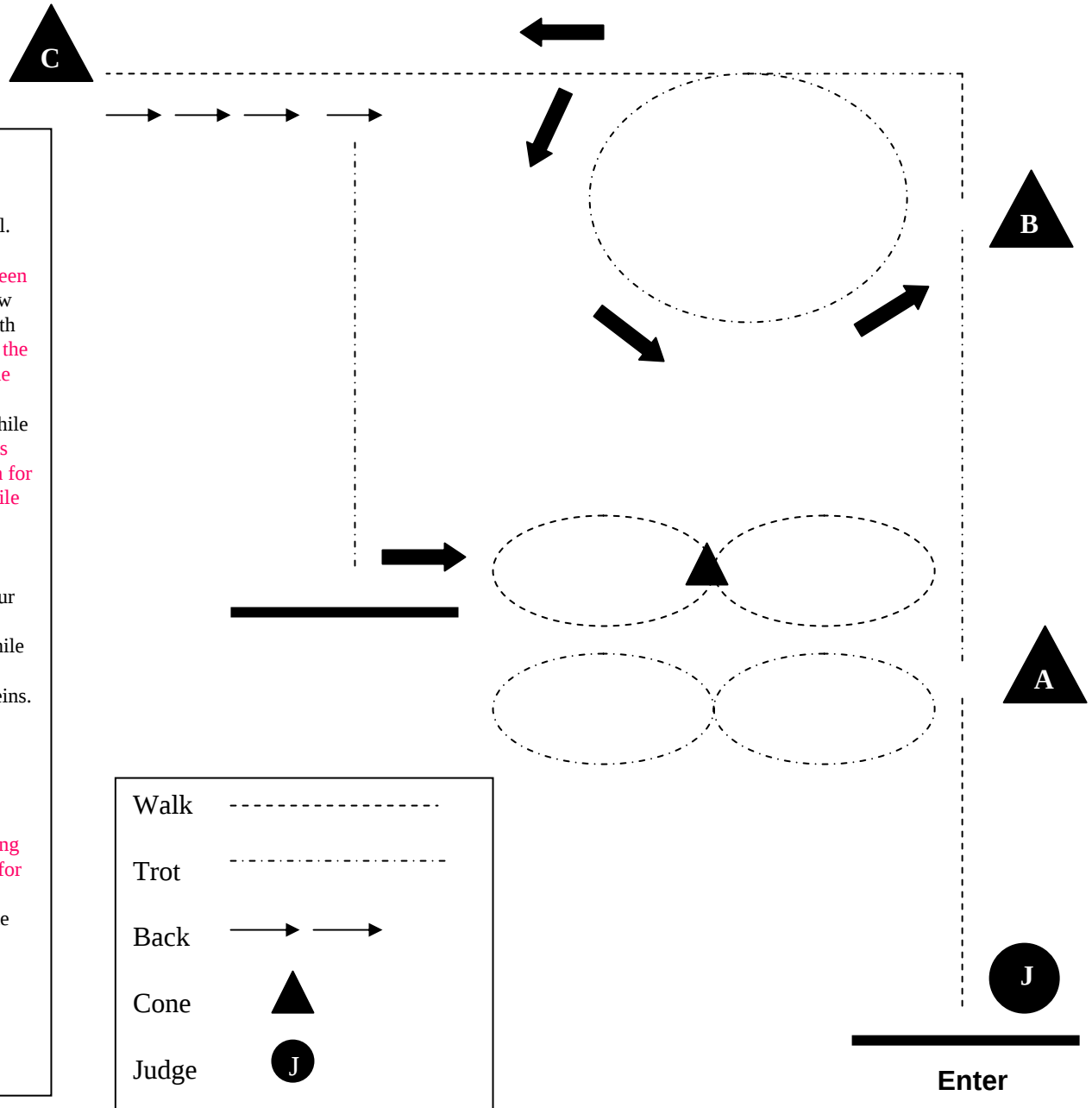
Performance Level 1 Riding Test

1. Be ready at the pole unmounted with your horse. Describe to the Judge how to approach another horse while mounted. **Never approach closely from behind. Make sure other horse can see your horse.**
2. Show how to check the fit of your girth. **Slide hand between it and the lower belly**
3. Walk your horse into the ring past the pole. Halt.
4. Mount your horse, with assistance if necessary.
5. Walk to Cone A. Halt.
6. Drop and regain stirrups without using hands.
7. Trot to Cone B. Halt.
8. Walk over ground poles in a two point position.
9. Trot to Cone C. Reverse at the trot and continue to Cone D.
10. Halt.
11. Say Thank You to the Judge and listen for further instructions.



Performance Level 2 Riding Test

1. Be ready at the pole with your horse in hand.
2. Explain how to fit the proper length of your stirrup. Both sides should be equal. Hang leg down and see where it lays compared to the ankle. Should be between the anklebone and the heel. Explain how you would adjust the length of your girth while mounted. Move leg forward past the knee. Lift the saddle flaps and adjust the girth straps.
3. Explain precautions you should take while riding in a group. Wait until everyone is mounted. One horse length. Red ribbon for kicker. Cross roads all at once (single file preferred)
4. Walk your horse to cone A.
5. Trot to Cone B.
6. Trot a simple circle. Halt. Lengthen your reins.
7. Walk to Cone C. Drop your stirrups while walking. Pick up your stirrups without using your hands. Halt. Shorten your reins.
8. Back four steps. Turn left $\frac{1}{4}$ turn.
9. Trot to the pole. Halt and turn left.
10. Walk a Figure 8.
11. Trot a Figure 8.
12. Halt.
13. Answer the Judge's questions concerning the tack on your horse and the reasons for its use. Thank the Judge.
14. Go to the Wrap Station and demonstrate how to properly apply a shipping wrap with assistance.



Performance Levels 1 and 2 Riding Test

- 1. Study and practice your riding pattern before you come.**
- 2. If you need someone to call out your pattern, please tell the Judge.**
- 3. You must pass Level 1 before taking Level 2.**
- 4. Study and know the answers to the informational questions before you come to the testing.**
- 5. Make sure your horse is well groomed and your tack and clothing are clean.**
- 6. Make sure you are wearing safe and neat attire. You must have an ASTM/SEI helmet and hard-toed riding shoes.**
- 7. The mane and tail of your horse should be combed and free of debris. In addition, appropriate areas of your horse should be trimmed as suitable to your riding discipline.**
- 8. You can perform the test English or Western.**
- 9. Your mom or dad can not help you while you are taking the test. You must be able to do this on your own.**
