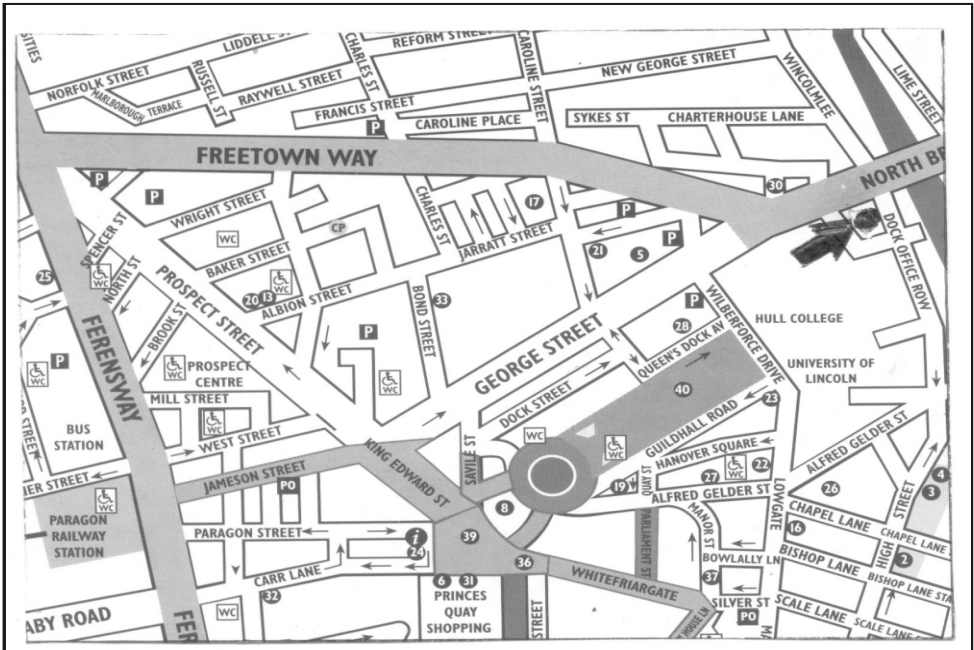

Welcome to the Hull Real Ale & Cider Festival 2009 and to the Horncastle Building, which is part of Hull College. This is our second year at this venue and those that came last year will notice that we have made some layout changes.

TOMBOLA

The pub & brewery related tombola has again been organised by John Heckford, the Branch's Pubs Officer for East Yorkshire.

Tickets are 25p each and the chances of winning something are high with a massive total of 1000 donated prizes:

400 main prizes including glasses, T-shirts, baseball caps, meal vouchers and bottles of beer, wine and spirits.

300 prizes of a half pint of real ale or cider/perry.

300 consolation prizes of key-rings, bottle openers, pens etc.

Every ticket that contains a number (any number) wins one of the main prizes. During the day and early evening the winners will probably have their good fortune greeted with the sound of a hand-bell and a cry of "And another lucky winner!"

TOKENS

This year we have decided to introduce tokens for the purchase of Real Ale, Cider, Perry and Bottled Beers. This system has been in operation at CAMRA Festivals throughout the country for many years. It has proved to be preferable for security reasons, but also enables customers to be served more quickly at the bars.

The Tokens are available from the Tokens Office, that is situated near the entrance to the festival. They cost £1.10 each and you can buy as few, or as many, as you want.

We will give you a full refund for any unused tokens. Alternatively you can put them in the charity box at the Tokens Office and we will donate £1.10 for each one received, to the Yorkshire Wildlife Trust. Please ensure that you do one or the other, as each one that is not returned is expensive for us to replace.

Using the tokens is very easy. For real ales up to 3.9% you will not need to use any additional cash. For real ales above 3.9%, Cider & Perry, and Bottled Beers, you will need to supply a small amount of cash with your token or tokens. See the price guide to the right. Please provide the exact amount of cash required when possible.

DISPENSE

HANDPUMP BARS

Last year's Handpump Bar has been split into two and moved into the main part of the building. The two bars will have a total of 36 hand-pumps, dispensing beers up to 4.3% ABV.

Clean glasses will be used on each occasion that you order beer from these bars.

GRAVITY BAR

The Gravity Bar has 40 stronger strength beers (4.4% - 6.9%) and they will all be served by gravity, direct from the cask.

The same glass will be used on each occasion that you order beer from this bar - unless you specifically request otherwise.

CIDER AND BOTTLED BEER BAR

The Cider and Bottled Beer Bar is situated just to the right of the Gravity Bar.

3.0% to 3.9% ABV = 1 Token
4.0% to 4.9% ABV = 1 Token + 10p
5.0% to 5.9% ABV = 1 Token + 20p
6.0% to 6.9% ABV = 1 Token + 30p

PINT

3.0% to 3.9% ABV = 2 Tokens
4.0% to 4.9% ABV = 2 Tokens + 20p
5.0% to 5.9% ABV = 2 Tokens + 40p
6.0% to 6.9% ABV = 2 Tokens + 60p

CIDER & PERRY PRICES

HALF PINT

5.0% to 5.9% ABV = 1 Token + 20p
6.0% to 6.9% ABV = 1 Token + 30p
7.0% to 8.5% ABV = 1 Token + 40p

PINT

5.0% to 5.9% ABV = 2 Tokens + 40p
6.0% to 6.9% ABV = 2 Tokens + 60p
7.0% to 8.5% ABV = 2 Tokens + 80p

BOTTLED BEER PRICES

BELGIAN

4.0% to 5.0% ABV = 2 Tokens + 50p
6.0% to 7.0% ABV = 3 Tokens
7.0% to 9.5% ABV = 3 Tokens + 50p

GERMAN

4.8% to 5.4% ABV = 3 Tokens
7.0% to 8.0% ABV = 3 Tokens + 50p

NB: There is a deposit of £1 on the bottle and glass - refundable on return.

This festival uses oversized, lined glasses to ensure that you receive a full half pint or pint of liquid, and to help prevent spillage. We do not use special commemorative glasses.

FESTIVAL STAFF

The festival staff are all unpaid CAMRA members that are giving up their time to ensure that you have a good time. Please be patient at busy times.

NO SMOKING

Please note that smoking is not allowed anywhere in the festival building. If you need to go outside for a smoke a pass is available at the reception that will allow you to regain entry.

Children are allowed in the Dining area until 5.00 p.m. They are expected to be well supervised by a parent or guardian. Colouring books and crayons are available on loan from the Membership Stand.
