1. Numbers will not be released without a signed entry and open check.
2. All riders must wear protective headgear while mounted.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any event with less than 3 entries
4. All scratches must be made through the show secretary. Class fees will not be refunded once a class has started.
5. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for returned checks.
6. Please park on designated areas only.
7. Leashed dogs are welcome!
8. The officials listed in the prize list have been invited to officiate, but could vary if situations arise.
9. All horses must have negative coggins.
10. This is a no smoking facility. Please refrain from smoking while on the grounds.
11. The show will be held according to WNEPHA and USEF rules.

DIRECTIONS

From the North:

Take Route 7 South into Great Barrington. Take a right on Rt 23 west, then another right on Rt 71. Take your first left onto Seekonk Cross Road. Horse show will be on your right.

From the South:

Take Route 7 North into Great Barrington. After Big-Y plaza take your first left onto Silver Street. At the end of Silver Street, take a left on Rt 23 west. Take a right on Rt 71, then first left onto Seekonk Cross Road. Horse show will be on your right.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Walk/Trot- Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. May not enter any other division.

Advanced/Adult Walk/Trot- Open to riders 13 and over who have never shown at the canter. May not enter any other division.

Long Stirrup- 18"- Open to riders 13 and over. Riders may not enter any other division where fence height exceeds 18".

Short Stirrup- 18". Open to riders 12 and under. Riders may not enter any other division where fence height exceeds 18".

Short Stirrup Medal- Shown over an equitation course of 8 fences. Must be WNEPHA member.

Leadline- Open to beginner riders under age 12 that have not shown off the leadline before. May not enter any other division. Must be lead by an adult.

Beginner Hunter- 18"- Open to green horses or riders that have not shown over 18". Horse/rider combination may not enter any other division where fence height exceeds 18".

Beginner Eq- 18"-Open to jr or adult riders that have not shown over 18". May not enter any other division where fence height exceeds 18".

Pleasure division- To be shown walk, trot, canter, both directions of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, and suitability. May be asked to extend the gaits and back up. Stake class to pay \$100, \$75, \$50, \$25

Schooling Hunter- 2'. Open to beginner horses or riders. No rider restrictions. No combinations. Horse/rider combination may not enter any other division where fence height exceeds 2'3.

Baby Green Hunter- 2'3. Open to horses in first or second year of showing that have never competed over 2'6. No oxers or combinations.

Novice/Jr Hunter- 2'3. Horses may not compete over 2'6 in any class at the show. No oxers or combinations. Open to juniors and amateurs only.

Jr/Amateur Hunter- 2'6. Open to junior and amateur riders, horse and rider combination may not jump over 2'6 at this show.

Harmony Hill Hunter Classic 2'6- No horse or rider restrictions. To consist of two numerically scored rounds, which will be averaged and pinned. Class #54-Low Hunter O/F- Handy, will count as first round in Classic. Cooler and eight ribbons to be awarded. Prize Money \$250,\$125,\$75,\$50

Mini Equitation- 2'6.Open to junior riders. Course may include combinations.

Adult Equitation and Hunter- 2'6-. Open to Adult Amateurs. Course may include combinations.

Handy hunter classes may include trot fence and bending lines.

Adult Medal- 2'6-2'9. Open to Adult Amateur members of the WNEPHA. May include combinations.

Low Hunter- 2'6. No restrictions.

Limit Equitation- 2'9. Open to Junior riders. Course may include combinations.

Limit Medal- 2'9. Open to Junior Members of the WNEPHA. May include combinations.

Open Equitation- 3'. Open to Junior Riders. May include combinations.

Junior Medal- 3'. Open to Junior Members of the WNEPHA.

Childrens Hunter- 3' Horses, 2'6 ponies. May be combined

Open Working/Junior Hunter- 3'3. No horse or rider restrictions. Course may include combinations.

Trainers award- Presented to the trainer with the largest number of competing horse and rider combinations. Trophy and \$500 cash.
