LEADERS' POLICY

All leaders are volunteer adults devoting their time to serve the scouts of Bạch Đăng League.

1. Any adult, who wants to join Bạch Đăng League as a leader, is invited to attend a leader conference with Bạch Đăng League leadership panel (consisting of the head of the organization and his/her two top lieutenants responsible for Girl and Boy Scout sides) in order to:
 - Determine whether the person meets BSA Boston Minutemen Council and/or GSBMC criteria to be a leader.
 - Determine if he/she will be admitted as a leader or an assistant leader.
 - Introduce the candidate to Bạch Đăng League policy, structure, and activities.
 - Get to know each other, and share experiences, knowledge.
 - Tentative assignment such as which scout's level he/she is associated with, and the scope of his/her responsibilities.
2. Leaders have to register with Bạch Đăng League and Boston Minutemen Council Scout Office (\$30.00 per year), and wear uniform to scout all meetings/activities/events unless otherwise announced.
3. Leaders will not use scout for personal gain financially, politically or other purposes that may promote one's own self interest.
4. Leaders promise to abide by the Scout Laws. Display good manners and work ethic.
5. Attendance to the scout meetings/activities/events is very important, one leader absent, the rest of the leaders will have to pick up the extra task. Please call and inform the leader in charge if you cannot make it due to urgent condition, even only to regular meetings.
6. Chronic absence, excessive tardiness, uncooperative attitude would be ground for discipline including dismissal which will be determined by Bạch Đăng League leadership panel.
7. All leaders must comply to Bạch Đăng League policy.
