Our Students

In its short existence, the students of IET have shown great promise through their achievements. The first batch of IET is likely to pass out in the month of June 2000. The students are encouraged to participate in various cultural and technical activities organized by sister institutions across the country. The students have won laurels in these activities.

At TechKriti 2000 organized by the Indian Institute of technology, Kanpur our students won prizes in various events viz. " Mix-n-Match ", "On-the-spot programming contests", "Hardware Model Contests" etc. At TechEra 2000 organized by the students of HBTI Kanpur, our students participated and won. Students also participated at SRMSCET, Bareilly and won large number of prizes.

1. Eligibility Condition for Admission :-

1.1 Academic Qualification

The minimum qualification for admission to B. Tech. program through the admission test is a pass in the final examination of the 10+2 system or its equivalent with a paper each in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics, referred to as the Qualifying Examination hereafter.

1.2 Reservation :-

- (i) As per U. P. Government rules.
- (ii) Seats are also reserved for NRI/NRI-sponsored candidates as per rules.

1.3 Date of birth :-

Date of birth as recorded in the high school, secondary education board, University certificate only will be considered as acceptable.

1.4 Physical Fitness :-

It is essential that the candidate possesses good general physique and normal vision and hearing. There should be no abnormality in heart and lungs and no history of mental disease or epileptic fits. It is advised that the applicant gets himself/herself medically examined to ensure the requisite medical standards, before submitting his/her application.

1.5 Certificates Required

- (i) Attested photocopy of the high school/secondary education board/University Certificate as proof of age.*
- (ii) Attested photocopy of the original certificate of passing the qualifying examination (10+2) level.*
- (iii) A certificate in original from an approved District Authority for reserved categories as enclosed with the application form.*
- (iv) A domicile certificate from the district magistrate of the concerned district of U. P. for the candidates residing outside U. P.*

Note: Domicile Requirements

- (i) Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from institution located in Uttar Pradesh.*
- (ii) Candidates whose parents are domicile of U. P. but have passed qualifying examination from institution outside U. P.

2. Admission Procedure

1. Admission to the B. Tech. program will be made through an entrance test.
2. The NRI/NRI sponsored candidates will not be required to appear in the entrance test. They will be admitted according to the merit in the qualifying examination.
3. The NRI/NRI sponsored candidates residing abroad may apply on plain paper alongwith the prescribed fee.
4. Categories :- A (Normal Seats) B (Self Supporting Seats) C(NRI/NRI sponsored seats)
5. The information brochure containing the application form can be obtained by post upto April 30 2000 by sending a DD of Rs. 575/- in favour of Finance Officer, Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj University, Kanpur, payable at Kanpur along-with a self-addressed, unstamped envelope of size 28cm.x 28cm. (A4 Size) to the Director, IET, CSJM University, Kanpur 208024. It can also be obtained from the extension counter of the Bank of Baroda, CSJM University Kanpur by April 30 2000 by submitting bank draft of Rs. 550/-. Applications complete in all respects must reach the Director, IET, CSJM University, Kanpur 208024 latest by May 10 2000 by registered post.
6. Forms after April 30 and upto May 25 2000, can be obtained from the office of IET on additional payment of late fee of RS. 300/- and submitted latest by May 25 2000.

2.1 Admit Card

The admit card will be issued to all eligible candidates by May 25 2000. If the admit card is not received by May 25 2000, the applicant should contact the Director, IET CSJM University, Kanpur in person from May 26 to May 31 2000, between 11AM to 5PM to obtain the duplicate admit card. The candidate must bring an attested copy of his/her photograph which he/she has pasted in the application form.

2.2 Entrance Test :

The entrance test will be conducted according to the following schedule.

Day and Date
Sunday June 4, 2000

The papers will contain only objective type questions in each subject. *The candidates must bring their own HB Pencil and an eraser.*

2.4 Result :-

the result of the entrance test is expected to be declared by the University by June 20, 2000. It will be displayed on the notice boards within the University and will also be published in selected newspapers.

2.5 Selection and Counselling :-

1. Counselling of the students selected on the basis of the entrance test for all the categories will be held during July 5 – July 15 2000 in the auditorium of the MBA building of the University campus.
2. Classes for the 2000 batch of students commence on July 26, 2000.
3. A merit list of the candidates is prepared on the basis of the total marks obtained in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. If the total marks obtained are equal, better rank is given to the one who obtains more marks in mathematics. If the total marks as well as the marks obtained in mathematics are same, better rank is given to the one who obtains more marks in Physics. If the marks in all the three subjects are the same, then equal rank is given to the candidates.
4. At the time of counselling, the candidates will be allotted seats caste category-wise strictly in order of merit. Candidate will have option to choose a branch of their choice at their merit call from seat category A or B depending on availability. Merit is based solely on the basis of entrance examination and there are no marks assigned for counselling.
5. If a candidate is absent at the time of his/her merit call, one loses the chance of selection/choice seat.
6. ST vacant seats are transferred to SC category, SC vacant seats are transferred to OBC category.

2.6 Admission form and fee

Selected candidates desirous to join the engineering program of the Institute of Engineering and Technology of the University shall be required to fill up an admission form at the time of their reporting and to deposit the fees as per directive from AICTE/State Government/University Body/Supreme Court.

Note : 50% of the total seats will be allotted to seat category A and the remaining 50% of the total seats to seat categories B and C. Fee structure may be revised from time to time depending on the instructions from the Government.

2.7 Hostel Facility

Limited hostel facility is available for girls in the University campus. Boys are advised to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging, but the institute helps them in this as far as possible.
