To the business end. As fall is approaching quickly, we will need to quickly nail down a few potential sites for well heads. How do we plug into the services of Steve Winkley? From a laymans perspective, there appears to be many potential sites for well heads versus a very limited number of sites for subsurface wastewater treatment. One area that comes to mind is where the old village wells were at the end of Gilbert Rd. If there, the storage tanks could be placed on the hill top in Fern Park. Just an idea.

Lastly, We realize you are not professional consultants, but you have tons of hands on experience. Thus, we would like to to assist us with some reality checks. We do not wish to put in something that "just won't work" or a beast to maintain. I and the engineers reviewed with you what we see as our potential 'critical needs", what we determined was of major concern to the public on the last project proposal, and what alternatives we are investigating in this project. You also did a walk through to see where our 'critical needs' were and the potential first cut sites for water and subsurface waste treatment.

From what we presented to you at the August 24th meeting, would you be so kind as to provide us with a letter as to your teams impression of feasibility or lack of it on the direction and approaches we are currently investigating. I realize utopia would be to have public sewers and water throughout the town and have it free for all users. But, again, reality dictates we must provide infrastructures that are both affordable and socially acceptable to the residents.
