A regular meeting of the Clean Waters Committee was held on Tuesday, July 25, 2006 in the meeting room of the Inlet Town Hall at 6:30 PM.

Dayt Cleaveland welcomed Sherry Grimm and Brad Donovan to the meeting and updated them what this committee has been working on including the recent drilling attempt at Fern Park. It was noted that the drill site is currently bubbling over and this led to discussions on what might have gone wrong, and some possible suggestions on what to do next at this site. Dayt continued to explain that the Town is currently seeking funding and a new location to drill.

Sherry Grimm spoke about her well and the property she has. The group discussed some possible options and ideas of how the Town and Sherry might be able to work together and provide a public water source. Ideas included possibly using Sherry's existing well, which at the time it was drilled produced 64 gallons per minute. Some questions that came up were whether a municipal system needs to have double casing, and how big a municipal storage tank would need to be. The group also discussed the possibility of drilling on Sherry's property.

The group will invite Micky Lehman & Matt Cooper to attend the next meeting and ask them to be available to answer questions on what options the Town might have with this new information from Sherry.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 22, 2006 at 6:30 PM in the Meeting Room of the Inlet Town Hall.
