Clean Waters Committee  
September 25, 2007

A regular meeting of the Clean Waters committee was held on September 25, 2007 in the Inlet Town Hall at 6:30 PM.

John Frey explained that Matt Cooper of Bernier, Carr & Associates had sent out RFPs to Jay Billings and Steve Winkley for test drilling. It was noted that the Town of Inlet has grant money set aside for this test drilling. Adele Burnett stated that Matt had not heard back from Jay and Steve, but expects to before the Town Board Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, October 9. It was then decided that this committee would hold a Special Meeting on October 9 at 5:30 PM to discuss what comes back from Jay Billings and Steve Winkley.

The committee briefly discussed the water meters that were to be place at a few locations to get an idea of what the readings might be. Dayt stated that he would look into this and see about getting the meters in place.

The committee then discussed the idea of the Town of Inlet setting up a "sewer fund" to be used by individual taxpayers as a low interest loan to fix any sewer issues they have. This led into a discussion on the different types of systems that could be used by individual property owners and how it has been proven on a small downtown lot that this is possible.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 23 at 6:30 PM in the Inlet Town Hall.

With nothing else to discuss at this time, the meeting adjourned at 7:05 PM.
