September 26, 2006

A regular meeting of the Clean Waters Committee was held on Tuesday, September 26, 2006 in the Inlet Town Hall at 6:30 PM.

Adele asked the committee if they had any feedback for Matt Cooper on his Preliminary Engineering Report. Of the members present, only Brad Donovan had had the chance to review the document. These were his questions/comments that were forwarded on to Matt:

- What, if any, type of chlorination would be used in a public water system?
- Why are the seasonal EDUs so high in section 2.2?
- Where are the test results from section 3.2?
- For the numbers in section 3.3, some places must have failed more than one test?
- Section 4.0 - Cost to operate?
- Section 5.3 –
 - o How many wells?
 - o \$ for the storage tank 150,000 not 150,00
 - o Regulated before entering homes?
 - o Fire protection? (thought this was to be removed)
- Section 6.0 - the O&M seems low, does this include payroll and electricity?
- Water Testing - has there been DOH failures since this report?

Dayt Cleaveland stated that he has yet to contact Steve Winkley. He will try to set up a meeting with him on Monday, October 9 between 1:00-2:00 PM to do a walk through of Sherry Grimm's property.

It was stated that currently there is no definite plan. Sherry asked about testing to be done on her well that was discussed during the September 11 walk-through. Adele will contact the engineers and inquire about this.

There was a brief discussion on the proposed Onsite Wastewater Ordinance. It was stated that this committee had worked with Ron Miller and members of the Planning Board on this ordinance. The ordinance was designed to ensure the proper installation and maintenance of onsite wastewater systems within the Town of Inlet.

Ken Nelson asked if everyone on the committee agreed that the Town should be pursuing the idea of putting in a public water system. It was stated that no one on the committee has said that they disagree with the idea, and this is why they have continued forward.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 24, 2006 at 6:30 PM in the Meeting Room of the Inlet Town Hall.

With nothing else to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 7:20 PM.
