Clean Waters Committee
February 28, 2006

A regular meeting of the Clean Waters Committee was held on Tuesday, February 28, 2006 in the meeting room of the Inlet Town Hall at 6:30 PM.

Matt Cooper presented the group with three bid quotes for test well drilling with the lowest from Jay Billings of Ron Gill Drilling. The committee agreed to send a recommendation to the Town Board to hire Ron Gill Drilling to begin test drilling at Fern Park when the weather breaks. It was noted that there is grant money set aside for this. The group briefly discussed the location of where the drilling should be done taking into consideration the recreational use of the park and the fact that this location is used for emergency helicopter landings.

Matt stated that he spoke with Susan Kennedy of the NYS Department of Health who, at this time, does not have an update on the water testing done by the interns over the summer.

There was a brief discussion on EDU counts. Adele will email the document that was given to her by Matt with the most recent numbers. The group discussed water meters and decided to recommend to the Town Board that meters, like ones that would be used if a system were put in, be installed on the following properties: Tamarack Café, John Frey's (3 units housing families of 4, 1 & 1), Dayton Cleaveland III (family of 3), JR Risley's (family of 2), and Dan Levi's (family of 5).

The group agreed that a March meeting would not be necessary.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 25, 2006 at 6:30 PM in the Meeting Room of the Inlet Town Hall.

With nothing else to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
