

Town of Inlet
Clean Waters Committee
November 29, 2005

A regular meeting of the Clean Waters Committee was held on Tuesday, November 29, 2005 in the senior room of the Inlet Town Hall at 6:30 PM.

Matt Cooper presented the group with information on possible public water systems. He explained that if the Town of Inlet does not qualify to receive any money from the New York State Revolving Fund, an estimated cost for a public water system would be \$971 per EDU. This number exceeds the New York State Comptrollers limit. All agreed that this would not be reasonable to pursue. Matt explained that with money from the New York State Revolving Fund the estimated cost of a public water system per EDU would be \$326. And he further explained that this number would stay about the same no matter if the system only included the downtown core area or if it stretched out as far as from the bridge over Cedar Creek to the bridge by the Sixth Lake Dam traveling along Route 28. In order to qualify for any funds towards a public water system the Town will have to prove a hardship by documenting test failures within the area to be serviced. It was suggested to contact Susan Kennedy for some of this information. Matt will send this committee information on the point system used to determine hardship. It was also suggested that members of this committee should talk one-on-one with those who would be included in a public water system to find out if this is the direction they want to go.

It was reported that the test drilling would begin soon and that Jay Billings would be doing these tests.

Ron Miller stated that he would continue to work with this committee on updating the town's sewer ordinance.

Due to the holidays, the next regular meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 3, 2006 at 6:30 PM in the Meeting Room of the Inlet Town Hall.

With nothing else to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 8:00 PM.
