

DUBUQUE FIELD ARCHERS 2007 BOWHUNTER LEAGUE RULES

The Bow Hunter League is a ten week league starting on Wednesday June 6th at 6:00 p.m.

League week starts on Wednesday at 6:00 p.m. and ends the following Wednesday at 6:00 p.m.

League fee of \$20 includes a DFA league shirt and a steak fry at the end of the season (august or Sept.)

League fee needs to be paid by 6/20/07 to Randy or Beth Lester or Kevin Goerdts so we can get the shirts ordered.

Please let Randy or Beth know your shirt size.

Teams will be assigned by the software used for scoring.

To insure the league is competitive a handicap system will be used.

Please fill out your scorecard completely. Be sure to include your name, team #, league week your are shooting, and a total for each game

Week # will be posted above scorecard box.

If you need to miss a week due to vacation/work conflicts please shoot twice the prior week. To be fair, please shoot one weeks score from each course, instead of shooting two arrows at each target.

No major equipment changes are allowed, i.e. starting out using bare bow or fingers class and changing to sights and release.

Range finders are not allowed.

To encourage camaraderie among members, shooters are encouraged to shoot on Wednesday night, but not required.

No shooting will be allowed if there is anyone working on the range. A range closed sign will be put on the corner of the fence. Please respect the safety of others and don't ignore the sign.

There are a total of thirty targets, a mix of bag, bale and 3-D

The tree stand closest to the clubhouse will be used for both courses, (targets #1 & #2)

Odd weeks will be shot on field course. The fourteen bales on the field course have a spot target (bulls eye) and either a animal target on the bale or a 3-d target next to the bale. Shoot a spot target from the first stake at each position. Shoot an animal from the second stake at each position. (targets #3- 30)

Even weeks will be shot on the bow hunter course, shooting a combination of 3-D targets and bag targets. targets #3-30)

Do not cut the targets to remove stuck arrows. Push the arrow through, If your vanes/feathers rip they were not on very good anyway. We have spent a lot of time on these targets. Please don't destroy them .
