

## *Punti chiave* parlare dei gusti

### **Espressioni utili**

#### **Per parlare di quello che ci piace**

##### **importare a.** verbo ausiliare *essere*

Subject: the thing or person that is important

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: the person to whom it is important

NOTE: when *importare* means to import, it is a transitive verb

##### **essere simpatico/a a.** verbo ausiliare *essere*

Subject: the person who is liked

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: the person who likes him or her

##### **avere voglia di.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person who feels like something

Direct object: already present in the expression, *voglia*

Indirect object: NONE

The thing someone feels like is the object of preposition *di*

##### **interessarsi di.** verbo ausiliare *essere*

Subject: the person who is interested in something

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: NONE

The thing the person is interested in is the object of preposition *di*

##### **affascinare.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is fascinating or charming

Direct object: the person who is fascinated or charmed

Indirect object: NONE

##### **emozionare.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the thing that is thrilling, moving, or exciting

Direct object: the person who is thrilled, moved, or excited

Indirect object: NONE

#### **Per parlare di quello che non ci piace**

##### **essere antipatico/a a.** verbo ausiliare *essere*

Subject: the person who is disliked

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: the person who dislikes someone

##### **dare fastidio a.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is annoying

Direct object: already present in the expression, *fastidio*

Indirect object: the person who is annoyed

**deludere.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that disappoints

Direct object: the person who is disappointed

Indirect object: NONE

NOTE: Past participle **deluso**

**annoiare.** to bore.

Subject: the person or thing that is boring

Direct object: the person who is bored

Indirect object: NONE

**disgustare.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is disgusting

Direct object: the person or thing that is disgusted

Indirect object: NONE

**fare schifo a.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is disgusting

Direct object: already present in the expression, *schifo*

Indirect object: the person who is disgusted

**ripugnare.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is repulsive

Direct object: the person who is repulsed

Indirect object: NONE

### **Per esprimere indifferenza**

**non importare a.** verbo ausiliare *essere*

Subject: the person or thing that is unimportant, that someone does not care about

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: the person to whom it is unimportant, the person who does not care about something

**non interessare a.** verbo ausiliare *avere*

Subject: the person or thing that is not interesting

Direct object: NONE

Indirect object: the person who is not interested in something
