

Map Making

The attached map is of an imaginary continent. Use the map making rules and follow the instructions to complete the map.

1. Divide the continent into 3 countries.
2. Divide 1 country into 4 provinces
3. Draw at least 1 mountain range and name it.
4. Determine a location for the national capital of EACH country (should have 3) and the provincial capitals for each of the provinces; remember the symbols for a national and provincial capitals.
5. Determine the location of at least 2 other cities for each country.
6. Give the continent a name.
7. Label the bodies of water (ocean, sea, lakes, rivers).
8. Label each of the COUNTRIES using BLOCK letters (example CANADA); label each of the cities (example Ottawa).
9. The map scale is 1cm=50km.
10. Complete the map (BOLTS).
11. Colour the map.
12. BONUS: Add other features to the continent.
