1. Mixing of warm and cold currents, sun's energy reaching down in the shallow waters, large variety of shellfish and fish
2. a. Area contained within 370km of coastline
b. Spain has fished inside Canada's territorial limits
4. Conflict between around the islands of St.Pierre and Miquelon.
5. Longline-barbed hooks are laid out and on a long line
Purse seine-a long net circles a school of fish and is closed from the bottom
Otter trawler-boat pulls a huge "open mouthed" net

4. Clear cutting allows soil runoff. This creates ilt water conditions in areas where the salmon breed, which can cause a reduction in numbers.
