

Angrod



Angrod was the son of Finarfin and lord of the Noldor.

He was the elder brother of Galadriel and Aegnor, and the younger brother of Finrod Felagund. He joined the Exile of the Noldor to Middle-earth, where together with Aegnor he held the highlands of Dorthonion against Morgoth. Aegnor and Angrod were both killed in the Dagor Bragollach.

According to the 'Unfinished Tales', his wife was an Elven lady named Eldalótë and Orodreth was his son (not his brother as is stated in the Silmarillion), who escaped to Nargothrond when his father was slain. Angrod was thus the grandfather of Gil-galad, Orodreth's son (again reasoned from the 'Unfinished Tales' where Gil-Galad was stated as Fingon's son but this was confirmed as an editorial decision by Christopher Tolkien which he admitted as a mistake.)
