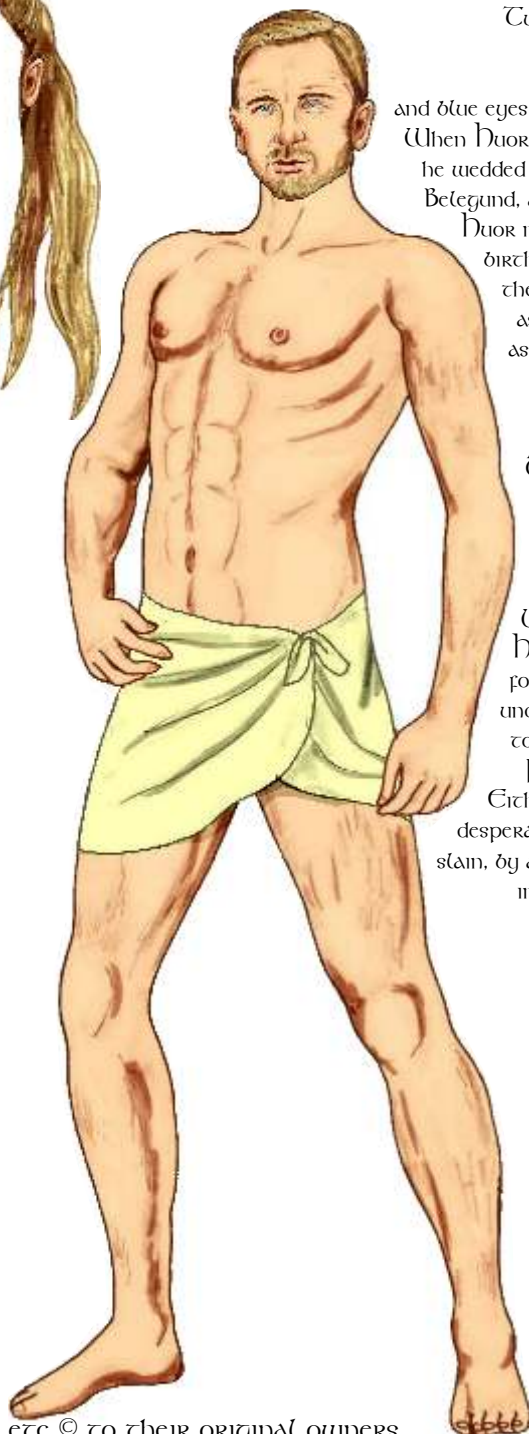


Huor



Younger son of Galdor, Lord of Dor-lómin.

Huor was in his turn the father of Tuor and grandfather of Eärendil the Mariner.

Huor had the fair hair and blue eyes of his grandfather's house. When Huor had grown to manhood, he wedded Rian the daughter of Belegund, and they conceived a son.

Huor named his son even before his birth, Tuor. Two months after the wedding, the Elven-lords assembled a great army to assail Morgoth, and Húrin and Huor went to join that army with the muster of Dor-lómin. This was the great battle that was to be called Nirnaeth Arnoediad, the Unnumbered Tears. Huor stood with the forces of his brother under the walls of the tower of High King Fingon at Barad Eithel but on the last desperate battle, he was slain, by a poisoned arrow in his eye.
