

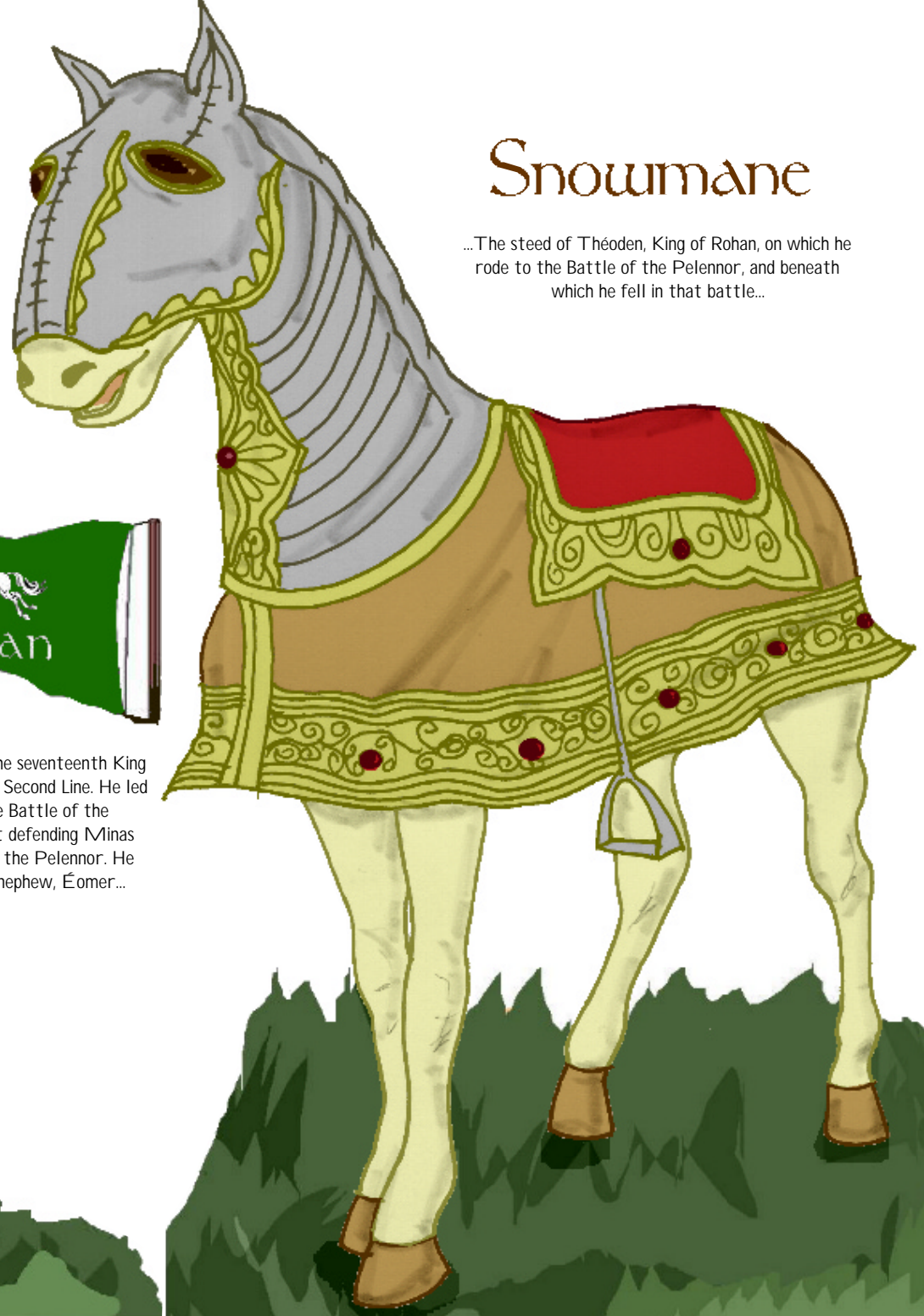
# Théoden, King of Rohan
