He will always have a special place in our hearts and his spirit will live on through the lives his charity touches.

What We Do

Beau's Wish Dog Rescue fills a very distinct void within the animal rescue world. Our rehabilitation foster program addresses the unique needs of rescue dogs that are too difficult to place in permanent homes because of anxiety, fears and phobias as a result of abuse and/or neglect. We are dedicated to nurturing and healing the physical and emotional wounds of the dogs in our care, and to restoring the dignity and quality of life they deserve.

Where Our Dogs Come From

Beau's Wish currently serves middle Tennessee. The dogs in our program come from several different sources; some are rescued from shelters, some are picked up as strays, and some are transferred from other rescue groups that don't have the resources to rehabilitate a dog with severe anxiety issues. Our goal is to eventually expand to serve the entire southern region.

How the Program Works

Upon entering our program, every dog visits the veterinarian and receives any and all necessary medical care. Most dogs are also assigned a new name. Their first week is spent acclimating to a new environment. Then, we address each anxiety, fear and phobia specific to that dog and begin the slow and steady process of reconditioning and retraining. Lastly, the dog is socialized in a variety of different scenarios and environments. Once the dog is ready for adoption, they are posted on PetFinder in addition to our website and all of our social media outlets.

Adopting a Dog from Beau's Wish

All of our dogs are spayed or neutered prior to adoption (with the exception of puppies under the age of 6 months). Potential adopters will be asked to complete an adoption application. The potential adopter will be asked to provide contact information for their veterinarian. One of our volunteers will contact the vet to make sure all of the potential adopter's animals are up to date with their vaccinations. We will also conduct a phone interview and a home visit. At that time, we'll discuss the dog's background and rehabilitation process so that the adopter is fully informed and prepared for the adoption.

Adoption Fees

- DOGS UP TO 1 YEAR OLD: \$200
- DOGS 1 TO 8 YEARS OLD: \$150
- DOGS 9 TO 10 YEARS OLD: \$100
- DOGS 11 YEARS & UP: A donation of the adopter's choice

If at any time an adopter feels they cannot keep their dog, Beau's Wish will provide free behavior consultations to try to keep the dog in the home.
