MR. CARL DAVID DOOLEY, AGE 62 YEARS, OF JEFFERSON CITY, MO. DIED SUNDAY, DECEMBER 28, 2008 AT HIS HOME.

MR. DOOLEY WAS BORN ON AUGUST 20, 1946 IN JEFFERSON CITY, MO. THE SON OF CARL E. AND HELEN L. JENKINS DOOLEY. HIS MOTHER SURVIVES IN JEFFERSON CITY, MO. HE WAS MARRIED ON JULY 4, 1969 IN JEFFERSON CITY, MO. TO GUNILLA M. WIDEN, WHO SURVIVES AT THE HOME.

HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE MISSOURI MOONSHINERS CAR CLUB.

AS A BELOVED SON, BROTHER, HUSBAND, FATHER AND FRIEND, DAVID WAS NEVER WITHOUT SOMEONE TO SHARE HIS MANY BLESSINGS. HE WAS THE "ALL AMERICAN BOY" THAT LOVED HIS COUNTRY, AND WHEN HE WAS CALLED TO DUTY, HE WENT WITHOUT HESITATION.

HE WAS AN AVID FAN OF WORKING ON OLD CARS AND CAR MODELS AND SHARED THAT HOBBY AND PASSION WITH MANY FRIENDS, INCLUDING HIS DAUGHTER. HE OFTEN TRAVELED TO BONNEVILLE, UTAH AND AUSTRALIA FOR SALT FLAT RACING.

HE WAS A GOOD MAN WITH A HEART OF GOLD. HE LOVED HIS FAMILY AND HIS MANY FRIENDS. HE WAS VERY MUCH LOVED BY MANY AND WILL BE MISSED DEARLY.
