

# CUTCLIFFE REUNION

Plans are underway for another North American Cutcliffe reunion to be held **July 21-24 2005** on Prince Edward Island, Canada. The intention of this letter is to determine approximate numbers of those who plan to attend from the United States, Canada and England.

We believe all Cutcliffes living in North America are descendants from Richard Cutcliffe who emigrated from Devon, England in 1840 to Prince Edward Island, Canada. Come to Prince Edward Island and visit the original home site and trace your roots from this family.

Our reunions are designed to be educational with respect to our Cutcliffe genealogy and will be fun to attend! We hope to have as much interaction as we can between the Island Cutcliffes and our visitors. We will have Island volunteers acting as guides for Island tours and information sessions.

Tom Cutcliffe from Kansas and Paige Cutcliffe from Alabama will attend and be resources on the Cutcliffe history and the American connections.

For Thursday and Friday evenings, we have booked a large community complex in Cornwall, a ten minute drive west of Charlottetown. On Thursday night, a genealogy night is planned to get everybody connected to the family tree. Introductions, family pictures, and other family information will be available. We meet again on Friday evening for the telling of family stories. On Saturday night, we go to Stanley Bridge (forty minute drive west of Charlottetown) for a dinner with a Cutcliffe Island historian as our guest speaker. A traditional Cutcliffe family picnic follows a Church service on Sunday.

Activities available during the reunion include a Cutcliffe historical tour of homesteads and cemeteries, driving tours of the Island, and walking tours of historic Charlottetown. Subject to the interest of attendees, social activities like golf, horse and wagon rides, beach fun, deep sea fishing, and live theatre could be arranged, if we know ahead of time.

Free Prince Edward Island information packages are available from our tourist bureau at 1-888- PEI-PLAY (1-888-734-7529). July is our **peak tourist season** so it is advisable to book early to get the best accommodations. We recommend Royal Park Country Inn as a convenient location.
