

## Scrappy September Mystery

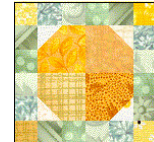
### Day 3

Today's step is all about finishing up! So you will need everything you have sewn + all the strips for the borders.

Sewing instructions:

#### Making the blocks:

We will start by making blocks from the parts you sewed yesterday. Take 4 of the yellow blocks, making sure they are all different, and lay them so that the yellows are touching. Join them to make a block. Do the same with all the other yellow blocks to make a total of 8 blocks.



Do the same with all the green blocks. You will have 8 blocks in total. The blocks will be 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " including seams.



#### making the top:

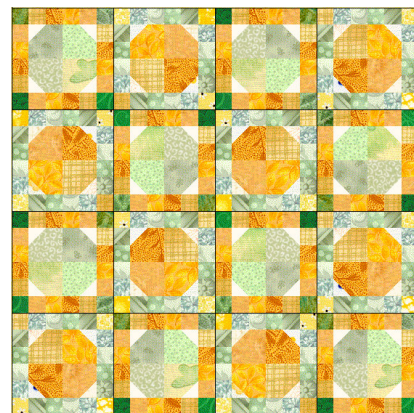
It's now time to join the blocks to make the top: Pair up a green and a yellow centred block and sew them together. Do the same with all the other blocks to make 8 pairs.



Join 2 sets of pairs to make a row making sure you alternate the blocks. Make a total of 4 rows



Join the rows to make the top alternating the rows as you go.



#### Adding the borders:

Sew all the light yellow border A strips to make one long strip. **Check your top to make sure it measures 48  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size if it's not that size adjust the size you cut your border to the correct size.** Cut off 2 strips of 48  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches and sew them to the top and bottom of the top.

Cut 2 strips of  $52 \frac{1}{2}$ " and sew them to the sides of the top.  
Ok you are by now wondering about all those pairs of green squares you have left over from day one.... Well it's time to use them too ☺

Take 12 pairs of the green squares you have left over and sew them to make a strip of 24 squares total, making sure you don't have 2 the same next to each other. Make a second row like that.

From the remaining green pairs of squares make 2 rows of 13 pairs (= 26 squares per row)

Sew the smaller 24 square rows to the top and bottom of the top.  
Sew the larger 26 square rows to the sides.

Sew all the dark yellow border B strips to make one long strip. **Check your top to make sure it measures  $56 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size if it's not that size adjust the size you cut your border to the correct size.** Cut off 2 strips of  $56 \frac{1}{2}$  inches and sew them to the top and bottom of the top.

Cut 2 strips of  $60 \frac{1}{2}$ " and sew them to the sides of the top.

Backing:  
divide the backing into half and sew them together to make the backing the correct size.

Quilting:  
An all over grid or free motion quilt pattern would look great on this quilt!

Binding:  
Cut the fabric for the binding into 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and join to make the binding.
