

Back to basics mystery

Step 2

With this mystery we are going to use 4 of the most basic colours of the colour wheel the 3 primary colours and green in 3 shades of each. It's going to be a fun little quilt with lots of **zing!**

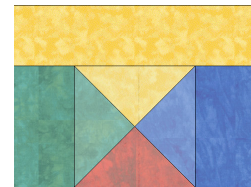
Finished quilt size is 40 inches square.

For this part you will need:

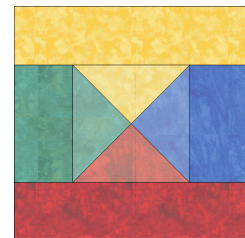
- ❖ All the remaining red/yellow/green/blue strips of 1 ½ inches wide.
- ❖ All the red/yellow/green/blue 2 ½ inch wide strips

Sewing:

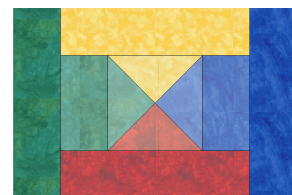
- ❖ Take the medium yellow strips and sew them to the side of the block with the yellow triangle so it looks like this:



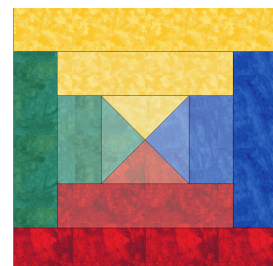
- ❖ Now take the medium red strips and add them to the block on the side of the block with the red triangle at this stage the block should be 4 ½ inches square.



- ❖ Since this is too small we will go one more round of the block to make it bigger first adding the dark blue and green strips so it looks like this:



- ❖ Now add the last 1 ½ inch strips to the top and bottom to finish the block. The block should be 6 ½ inches now.

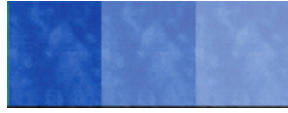


Now it's time to do something with the remaining

coloured strips:

- ❖ Keeping the different colours separate sew a dark to a medium and then sew a light against the medium to make a strip of $6\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ inches, you will have 4 of each colour. For example the blue one will

look like this:



- ❖ Now join each set to each other to make a long strip that looks like this:



dark light light dark dark light light dark

Make 4 of these in total
