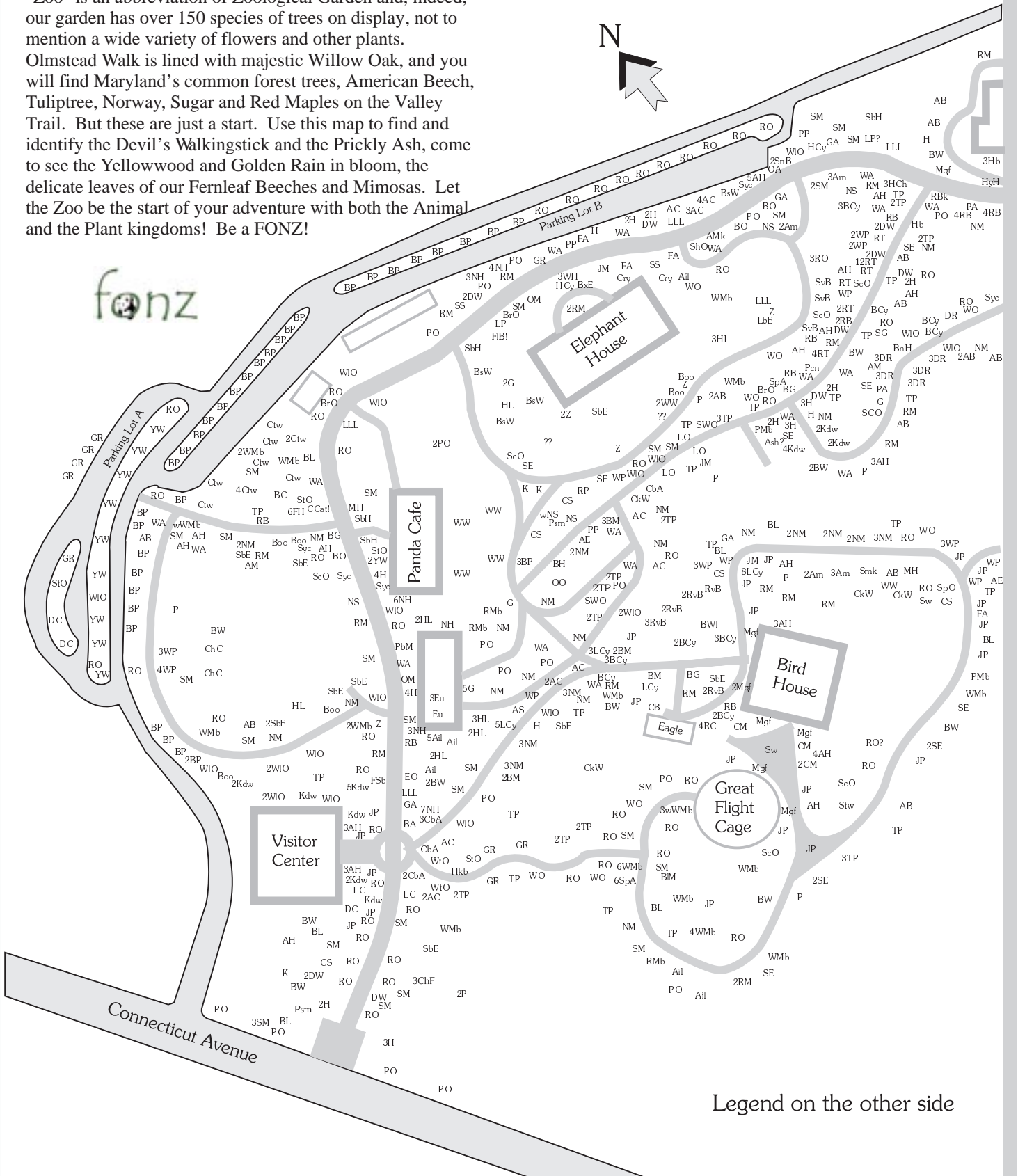


The Trees at the National Zoo, Washington DC

"Zoo" is an abbreviation of Zoological Garden and, indeed, our garden has over 150 species of trees on display, not to mention a wide variety of flowers and other plants. Olmstead Walk is lined with majestic Willow Oak, and you will find Maryland's common forest trees, American Beech, Tuliptree, Norway, Sugar and Red Maples on the Valley Trail. But these are just a start. Use this map to find and identify the Devil's Walkingstick and the Prickly Ash, come to see the Yellowwood and Golden Rain in bloom, the delicate leaves of our Fernleaf Beeches and Mimosas. Let the Zoo be the start of your adventure with both the Animal and the Plant kingdoms! Be a FONZ!
