



CHAPERONES MUST CHAPERONE!

First, **all adults must act as chaperones**. If anyone should see a Daughter doing anything unbecoming a Job's Daughter, her name and Bethel number should be recorded and reported to her own Guardian or chaperone. This is one of the reasons we all wear name tags. Don't be afraid to tell a girl that she is not acting properly.

Upon arrival at Green Lake, please check all rooms for damage before the girls enter and report any preexisting damage on the inspection sheet. Each Bethel is responsible for the rooms they occupy.

The use of shaving cream, toothpaste, Vaseline and glue is ABSOLUTELY forbidden. Costly pranks and property damage will not be tolerated and will be paid for by the individual Bethel causing the damage. Damage done to the property of the Conference Center will not be tolerated.

The Green Lake staff frowns on toilet-papering. Again, each room will be furnished with two rolls of toilet paper, period. If you think you might run out, be sure to bring toilet paper from home. Restrict decorating to indoor endeavors. We are not the only group on the grounds and do not want to infringe on others.

One chaperone should be appointed to keep the Bethel copy of the Emergency Medical Permission slips while on the grounds. Drivers should have them from the trip to and from Green Lake.

All Dads are expected to assist the Grand Bethel Associate Guardian in setting up Pillsbury Hall for Grand Bethel and church. One or two "Dads" or "Moms" from each Bethel should be available for security assignments.

Chaperones must set the example:

- Appropriate dress code for all attending Grand Bethel, church and the MWJD pageant;;
- No food or drink is allowed in Pillsbury Hall during any of the events;
- Those attending Grand Bethel are expected to remain in the Bethel Room until the meeting adjourns.

Please bring necessary needs for the Daughters (i.e. sanitary supplies, daily medical needs, aspirin, Tylenol, band-aids, etc.) Everyday medical needs should not and must not be sent to our medical staff. Minor problems, as stated, can be taken care of by the chaperones.

NOTHING may be sold at Jamboree without the PRIOR permission of the Jamboree Board.

Remember, because the Green Lake Conference Center is located in the open and surrounded by woods and a lake, bugs and some wildlife will be present. Try to ignore them and they will do likewise to you! Make the best of your surroundings.
