

## GUARDIAN LETTER - JAMBOREE 2009

Dear Bethel Guardian and Associate Bethel Guardian:

It has been said “one of the best things of being a Guardian or Associate Guardian is that you get to go to Jamboree”. This letter is primarily directed to the newer Bethel Guardians, but it can also act as a reminder to those who have attended Jamboree in the past.

Registration is a good place to start. Encourage the person taking care of that to read the instructions and PLEASE GET THE REGISTRATION AND MEDICAL SLIPS IN ON TIME. (JUNE 15, 2009)

MEDICAL Information Forms are required for ALL – daughters and adults alike. (Adults get sick and have accidents too.) We suggest you have two copies for each person attending Jamboree. One copy MUST be submitted with your Registration Form; the other copy should be retained and given to the driver of the people in their vehicle to and from Jamboree. (A “Medical Form” is included in your Jamboree packet. Please copy as needed.) This is the same one used for all Job’s Daughters travel events.

The guideline is one chaperone for each five Daughters in attendance. The minimum number of two chaperones covers the first ten Daughters (or fraction thereof) attending.

► **Because of insurance and liability reasons, Jamboree must become a CLOSED event. Everyone who enters the Green Lake grounds for the purpose of attending any Jamboree session or event must be registered. (This is defined by payment in full for the event and submission of a medical form.) Nametags and wristbands will be required of all attendees.** As Guardian, you will be responsible for anyone from your Bethel found violating this policy.

► Day and event passes are available for a fee. See the general information sheet for more details.

The Grand Bethel meeting is held on Saturday morning. We are asking you as Guardians, to instruct your girls attending Grand Bethel, that this is a Bethel meeting. In order to leave the meeting, while it is in session, Daughters must use the correct procedure. Girls interested in Grand Bethel, but not qualifying for membership, may attend, but cannot vote.

**The annual meeting of Jamboree, Inc. is held Saturday at 4:15 in the Mitchell Room of the Dining Room. As a Bethel Guardian or Associate Bethel Guardian, you are a voting member of this organization and are requested to attend.** It is at this meeting that an election is held for Board members who serve a three-year term.

One of the main topics of discussion is what constitutes “proper” attire for girls at Jamboree. Weather is an important factor. Our Job’s Daughters dress code is in effect for our girls and adults attending Grand Bethel meetings and church. Dads need to wear neat slacks and shirts to Grand Bethel and church. Other than those occasions, casual clothes can be worn. Ragged jeans, abbreviated and revealing tops, shorts and skirts are not proper. We’re asking you to be the judge when your girls ask, “What can we wear?” Please remember, Jamboree is meant to be an informal, fun-filled weekend for the girls.

If you have any questions regarding Jamboree, please contact me. If this is your first experience at Green Lake, look forward to it. It is an experience that you will always remember.
