## MEDICAL/SECURITY LETTER

The Jamboree Board will again have our own emergency medical team, in addition to the first aid services provided by Green Lake Center. EMTs and/or Registered Nurses will be in charge of all emergencies and be on duty at all times and for all activities. Those persons will be carrying walkie-talkies, have a complete emergency kit in their possession and will be readily available.

Twenty-four hours a day, help is available. Just press "0" on the phone. The Operator will notify their medical people as well as the Jamboree medical team. Help will be sent to you immediately.

Be sure to have the enclosed Medical Information Form duplicated, distributed to all **Daughters and Adults** for completion, and **returned** with the Jamboree Registration Form. Our Medical Team relies on these forms for emergencies, so make sure that medical conditions and medications are current. We suggest you copy the completed forms before submitting them and keep one of each for your drivers to carry to and from Jamboree.

We do ask that you handle any minor injuries and tummy-aches from too much snacking. Bring feminine materials, assorted band-aids, antibiotic ointment and Tylenol/Ibuprofen (if allowed), etc. for your Bethel girls' basic needs. This will relieve the pressure on our volunteers and allow them to enjoy Jamboree along with the rest of us. Bee stings and other bug bites may again be a problem. We ask you to help by knowing which girls and adults may have an allergic reaction and suggesting that they have their doctor prescribe an EpiPen. The EpiPen should be carried by them. The ambulance has about a 15-20 minute arrival time, so carrying the EpiPen is necessary. Meat tenderizer makes a soothing paste for any stings. Zip-Loc baggies can make ice packs. A disposable ice pack may be a good item to have with you. Our Medical Team will handle all medical problems, however, Guardians, you can be of help to them if your first-aid kit contains the above items.

**Each Bethel is required to have one or two adults assist with security.** Assigned times and locations will be e-mailed to Bethels before Jamboree. Assignments will be posted in Pillsbury Hall. The packet given at Registration will have a complete listing of the volunteers and their jobs. It will also be posted prior to Jamboree on the website. If there are conflicts, please help us by getting a replacement for your job. Check for your Bethel's time and have your security person be at their duty post on time. **Bring a flashlight and raincoat/umbrella if necessary.**
