

**JAMBOREE 2009**  
**AUGUST 21, 22 and 23, 2009**  
GREEN LAKE CONFERENCE CENTER

Welcome to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Jamboree! In celebration of this occasion, there are some new activities and changes to the schedule and event locations for this year. Please carefully read this letter and all other 2009 information and pass along information to your Bethel's attendees. Please also note all registration deadlines – there will be late fees assessed after the cutoff dates and space may no longer be available.

**Who may attend?:**

▶ All members of Job's Daughters and Bethel Guardian Council members are welcome to attend our Jamboree. Guardians, it is your decision as to who should attend.

▶ We are also inviting back any past Job's Daughters who would like to attend the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary Jamboree. Please register as individuals and not with your former Bethel.

▶ **Because of insurance and liability reasons, Jamboree is a CLOSED event. Everyone who enters the Green Lake grounds for the purpose of attending any Jamboree session or event must be registered. (This is defined by payment in full for the event and submission of a medical form.) Nametags and wristbands will be required of all attendees.**

**Registration:**

▶ Registration forms are available for downloading on the Jamboree website ([www.geocities.com/jobiejamboree](http://www.geocities.com/jobiejamboree)).

▶ **The deadline for registration is June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Your check for \$50 for each registrant (non-refundable), as well as medical forms for each person MUST accompany your registration.**

▶ **Space is limited. After the deadline, extra housing will be returned to Green Lake. Any registrations received after the deadline will incur a \$20 penalty and will be accepted only if space is still available.**

**Costs:**

▶ The cost for the full weekend will be \$100.00. This will cover two nights lodging plus the following meals:

Friday: Dinner and a hot dog feast at 11PM

Saturday: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Sunday: Breakfast only

▶ Lunch is available on Sunday right after the Grand Bethel Installation, but is not included in the cost of the weekend. If you choose to stay for lunch, you will need to purchase a ticket for \$10. Please indicate the number staying for lunch on your registration form. The cost will be added to your final total upon check-in.

▶ **All active Job's Daughters from Wisconsin Bethels will receive a \$20 reduction in the Jamboree fees.** Jobies who are 2007/08 Grand Bethel Officers, Choir and Representatives, and who have reached 20 years of age during the year, will be offered this reduction. The \$20 will be deducted from the final registration fees upon check-in.

### **Partial Registrations:**

▶ Partial registrations for single days and the Miss Wisconsin Job's Daughters pageant are available.

Friday Day Pass = \$25.00 and a medical form

Saturday Day Pass = \$25.00 and a medical form

Saturday MWJD pageant only = \$5

▶ Partial registration fees do not include any meals or lodging. Partial registrants are required to leave the Green Lake grounds or secure their own housing in a non-Jamboree issued room.

▶ Anyone found violating these policies will be charged the full weekend rate.

▶ Advance registration is required so that attendee lists can be given to the Front Gate and nametags prepared. Be sure to inform your MWJD contestant of this requirement.

▶ Register by filling out the Day/Event Registration form available on the website. Fees and medical forms will be collected upon arrival at Green Lake and nametags and wristbands will be issued specific to the registered events.

### **Check-In:**

▶ Check-in will begin at 1:30pm on Friday in the lobby of **Pillsbury Hall**.

▶ Room keys will only be available AFTER 4PM in the Pillsbury Hall Lobby. No exceptions!!

▶ A representative of the Bethel must first finalize the paperwork and pay the balance of fees. Each attendee must then collect their own nametag and wristband.

▶ All check-in activities will be in the Pillsbury Hall lobby. There is no reason to go to Kraft Hall this year.

### **Housing:**

▶ To get the rate we do, we must maximize the housing. Couples may be split up and women will be roomed with women and the men with men. People who need special arrangements must indicate this on the form. We will try our very best to accommodate all

wishes. Please know that some of the housing may require you to walk/drive to Pillsbury Hall.

▶ Bedding and towels will continue to be provided; however you will need to bring soap, shampoo and other personal toiletries.

### **Dining:**

▶ Food is served in the main dining room, cafeteria style (all you can eat), with two or three entrees, salads, soups, desserts, beverages, etc.

▶ A hot dog feast on Friday night is also included.

### **Activities:**

▶ Friday afternoon events:

Tram rides, special crafts and projects, scavenger hunt, button machine, etc. After you register, step inside Pillsbury Hall and get info and sign-up for all the activities.

▶ The Talent Show with the even-numbered Bethels will take place on Friday at 8:30pm in Pillsbury Hall. (Please note the earlier event time.)

▶ The 27<sup>th</sup> annual Jamboree Jog for HIKE will take place on Saturday at 6:00am (rain or shine). This is a great way to begin the day and raise money for our philanthropic project. Whether you run, walk or watch, please get pledges from family, friends and/or neighbors. Or just make a \$2 contribution to HIKE at the beginning of the Jog. We have set a fundraising goal of \$1500 for this event – please help us exceed our goal!

▶ Grand Bethel will have its annual meeting on Saturday with the Installation Ceremony on Sunday morning immediately following the church service. Grand Bethel events will be held in Pillsbury Hall.

▶ Sports will be held on Saturday morning and afternoon, with volleyball on Saturday afternoon.

▶ The traditional Jamboree crafts will be available Saturday morning and afternoon in Pillsbury Hall Lakeview.

▶ The Miss Wisconsin Job's Daughter pageant will take place on Saturday night at 7:30pm in Pillsbury Hall.

▶ Jamboree will commemorate its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary with a fireworks display at the lakeshore on Saturday night!

▶ The Chapel Car, Judson Tower, Fitness Center, Country Store, gift shop, Frisbee golf, tennis courts, bike rentals, pedal boats and swimming area will be available to us. A nominal fee will be charged for bike rentals.
