### **Chapter 1:**

#### **Summary**

Private companies use a concept known as competition which results in superior service to the customers. Governments use a concept known as bureaucracy which doesn't.

This article presents a plan to give the benefits of competition to everybody on earth, including employees.

The plan is similar to a union, but on a global scale. It would improve life for everybody.

It gets rather involved, so if you don't read the whole thing you might be left with an incomplete impression of it, you would feel that it won't succeed.

It will succeed if you give it an honest chance.

Competition has been well proven to provide the best service to the people. Governments use a one size fits all policy, which is ok for the plurality but usually leaves the majority wanting something better.

The following changes should start immediately, but only in a few limited areas, then expand gradually, so they don't cause any disruption to existing society.

### **Regions:**

The end goal is to split the world into about a thousand regions. Every human on earth would be a citizen of earth, and can pick whatever region they want to live in, except as mentioned later.

Each regions size would be determined by how many people choose to live there.

This way popular regions get more land and thus are not overcrowded.

This is competition, and will result in regions giving much better service to people compared to many of the corrupt governments around the world today.

Regions would have to compete with each other to offer the best possible service to the people,

else people will move to a better region, and the unpopular region will shrink and eventually go out of business. Can you imagine how much the quality of life will go up for everybody because of this?

Many regions will be run by private companies, some will still be run by governments.

Government run regions will have to compete so you will see their level of service rise too, though it is expected that the private regions will be the most desirable.

Regions would be required to use binding arbitration or other peaceful methods to resolve disputes. Wars will no longer happen.

They must agree to the use of peaceful methods or they will not be allowed to become a region.

All of earth will be regions, including regions that are run by governments. More about this later.

You will see all kinds of benefits arise from this, benefits you may not even be able to imagine now.

### **Labor:**

One benefit would be labor improvements.

In the old days, people used to work 12 or more hours a day. In fact some people still do, in third world countries where they are being exploited for cheap labor by big corporations.

Much of the world has come down and reached a plateau of a 40 hour work week. We don't seem to be able to improve to perhaps a 10 hour workweek.

Some regions will use more machine labor and other improvements such as eliminating redundant or unnecessary jobs, which will result in a pay increase and a reduced 10 hour workweek in those regions.

Everybody who wants a job will have one, nobody gets left out and unemployed. This is possible because with shorter hours there can be more people working.

You will be looking at a pay increase due to the greater efficiency of the regions as compared to the bureaucracy of the present system, regarding high taxes and all that.

It is common knowledge that much of the tax money is wasted by the bureaucrats today, which is yet another reason for change.

The purpose of all this is to have a higher standard of living.

All those efficiency improvements resulting from regional competition will result in a surplus of goods on the market, which means enough food to feed everybody so no more starving children.

Don't believe it? Read the whole book before jumping to any conclusions.

United States Vice President Cheney has publicly stated that there are more people working as tax preparers than there are soldiers in the army.

Can you imagine how much better off we would be if all those people were put to work doing something useful, and the tax code was simplified?

Or do you still think the government will ever improve without any competition?

For those who are unfamiliar with the U.S. tax code, it has a virtual encyclopedia set of regulations, loopholes, and other useless garbage that makes it a total nightmare to calculate taxes. Many people have to hire a tax preparer to try to figure it out.

If all those people were working on something useful instead, they could accomplish great things for humanity.

### **Alliance:**

One of the ways we will succeed is by forming an alliance with all good groups on earth. This will be necessary to have enough people to make it work.

This teamwork will enable us to accomplish our goals that we are presently too small to accomplish.

There are a lot of things you can do to help.

In fact, we can't do this without you.

We need you to tell people about this because some of them will join the effort and we need everybody we can get.

The whole world is seeing freedom erode away. Competition among regions will result in a major increase in freedom since few people would want to live in an unfree region.

Of course people won't actually have to move to acquire the benefits. Due to competition, all regions will want to improve so they don't lose their people to other regions.

### **Injustice:**

As long as much of the world is stuck in countries that don't allow people to leave, then people won't have the benefits of competition, and many people will suffer injustices.

These injustices take the form of labor and environmental problems, and also the crime problem.

We have already seen a huge number of people released from prison after 20 years, when DNA evidence proved they could not have possibly done the crime.

Other cases were a result of simple incompetence on behalf of the government system, botched evidence analysis, etc.

This could affect you next, or somebody you care about. This means the real criminal is still out there posing a danger to your family, while an innocent person is in prison for decades.

You yourself could be the next innocent person to be imprisoned and suffer terribly, for nothing.

All this can be avoided by the efficiency upgrade resulting from competition.

The lives of you and your children would be immeasurably improved if we make these improvements to society.

You cannot wait for other people to do this for you. It will not happen by itself, and santa is not going to give it to you.

You need to get involved.

Otherwise you condemn all future generations to bureaucracy, waste, decline of freedoms, and countless other needless suffering which will only get worse as the opportunity for change slips away.

### **Future:**

The future of the world can be a good one, or we can continue with the current situation of suffering, poverty, and injustice forever.

Remember the majority of people on earth presently live in poverty, and this trend will continue to expand if you allow it by failing to get involved in the alliance. It may even start affecting your area, stranger things have happened.

because time passes quickly, and changes happen.  
Problems spread. It may reach a point where it  
becomes impossible to stop the problems.

We must start discussing solutions to the problems

## **Chapter 2:**

This alliance will be large enough to succeed.

United we stand, divided we fall.

By working as a team, each individual group gains the ability to accomplish its goal.

When groups pool their resources and do other things together then they become much more likely to succeed and sooner.

There are many examples of this in history.

For now, we can call it "the alliance to save the world". Some creative person may come up with a better name, then we can change it.

But it doesn't really matter what we call it, as long as it accomplishes the stated goals.

To save time,

this publication refers to it as the alliance.

The alliance is similar to a union.

Have you seen how much higher the pay is for union

members compared to non union members?

Now imagine a union on a global scale, one that is inviting you to join the benefits.

This is a global alliance, not limited to one country.

All good groups across the entire planet are invited to join together to form the alliance.

That is one of the important keys to our success, the ability to team up with different groups with different goals. They do their thing, we do our thing, and we stand up for each others rights.

Alone we can't accomplish anything.

That means your goals will continue to fail too.

But a global team of billions of people, the alliance, can accomplish a lot of good things. Then your goals can succeed, at least as much as possible without imposing them on people against their will.

The alliance gives people rights if they want them, but doesn't force things on anybody. That is why it will become so popular that it will succeed.

More about this later.

The goals of the alliance are to end world suffering, starvation, terrorism, injustice, and poverty.

Other goals are to enrich peoples lives and make sure the future is a better place for the

future generations.

Sound impossible?

Don't dismiss this without reading it all.

There are a lot of details we will cover, that show how you can succeed.

There are a lot of things you can do to help even if you are not rich.

One easy thing you can do is tell people about this, because some of them will join the effort, and it is vital that we get as many people as we can.

If you are already a member of one of the groups, you can tell the group that you want them to form/join the alliance.

They may not join without support from their members.

If they refuse to join, cancel your membership and tell them why.

They may reconsider if they lose enough members.

Find or make another group to join, one that is part of the alliance.

This is your chance to do something that really matters, something that can make the world a better place now and for countless generations.

Anybody who doesn't believe that changes are needed should try watching the world news.

It is appalling how much unnecessary suffering is going on, not to mention how much more fun we could all be having.

If you fail to act now while you have the chance, and some of these world problems affect you or somebody you care about, then you only have yourself to blame for failing to act.

It is our world, we can make it better.

Joining some small group that is not part of the alliance probably won't make much difference, but imagine an alliance of 3 billion people. Now that will make a difference.

Don't expect many people to join the alliance just to help others. But when people find out that they can benefit themselves by joining, that's when a lot of people will join.

It is true that this may take some time.

But what is your alternative?

Are things going so well now that you think the present system will take care of the problems?

In current society, a plurality often decides the outcome, and the split-up majority loses.

In other cases, there are compromises where nobody gets what they need.

It does not have to be that way.

The alliance can establish different regions where people are free to move from one region to another. Each region has its own theme, its own way of doing things.

For example one region can be where one group can do things their way, and another region where another group does things their way.

This way everybody gets what they want, there are no losers.

Obviously these regions would start small. Then as more people want to join, the regions would gradually expand.

This way it does not cause any inconvenience to the rest of what we jokingly call civilization. Present day civilization is not that civilized.

The rich selfish people who run the world today have no incentive to accomplish any of these goals. They have everything they need.

Some of them actually enjoy watching you squirm. Many of them are just trying to impose their selfish agenda on you, whether you like it or not. And its working.

Freedom is fading away across the entire planet. Not all rich people are bad, keep reading for details.

All groups will be working together as a team, but the more emphasis that is placed on some goals could help accomplish those goals sooner.

If you are already a member of any existing group, tell the group that you want them to join the alliance.

They may not want to join until enough of their members express support for it.

It is probably better for people to join groups,

and have the groups join together to form an alliance, instead of people directly joining the alliance itself.

This is because any large group could become corrupt and/or incompetent.

But an alliance of smaller groups doesn't have that problem.

If one group becomes incompetent, the rest of the groups can simply refuse to have anything to do with it anymore.

Problem solved.

The alliance is inherently stable because no single group is in charge.

If one group goes bad, the rest of the groups expel it.

This is democratic because people always have the choice as to which group to join.

If a group starts to go bad, people don't have to wait years for another election to come along, they can just quit their membership in the bad group and join a better one.

This concept provides a constant steadying force that is not present with the current system.

4.

If you are fluent in another language, join a translation team to translate this book into other languages so the whole world can get involved.

This is too big a project to be solved by only a small part of the world, we need everybody we can get.

5.

Remain highly motivated.

It may take time to change things.

6.

Avoid spending money on things that are causing or perpetuating the problems. For example, consider boycotting companies that don't join or support the alliance.

If you run a company that makes products, join the alliance and place something on the label that indicates that the company supports the alliance to save the world.

A couple decades ago, the tuna industry changed its fishing methods to avoid harming dolphins because customers stopped buying tuna missing the "dolphin safe" label.

Boycotts work.

Money is one of the most important factors in our success. The power of money can buy virtually anything, just look how many governments have been corrupted by it. Now lets start doing something good with the power of money.

Like it or not, money exists and cannot be un-invented. We are stuck with it.

We have to start using it to our favor.

Money is an extremely powerful tool that can make us succeed. If most of the world starts buying products only from companies that benefit the alliance, then the alliance will control most of the money in the world, and then it would be guaranteed to succeed.

Who could stop it?

Anybody can start a company, so if it is difficult to find companies that are members of the alliance, then just get together with some friends and start your own company, and advertise it as being part of the alliance. Then it will be easy for people to do business with your company, taking business away from the companies that don't care enough about the future of the world to join the alliance.

Start small if necessary, work your way up.

Remember, we can't do this without you.

If you wait for others, and they wait for you, nothing will ever end up getting done, and nothing good will come of that.

## **Chapter 4:**

### **Machines to do the work.**

What is happening is that many factories got machines which reduced the need for human labor,  
and a lot of people got laid off from work.

Other people are not getting as much pay as they deserve, because wages are depressed across the board due to the surplus of labor and the way the system is run.

Building and servicing machines did create new jobs, but a lot of the new jobs are going overseas to people in third world countries.

Those people have to work 12 hours a day 7 days a week, give or take, more in some situations, all for appalling low wages and usually bad working conditions too.

The alliance could solve all these problems by

setting basic human rights, environmental protections,  
and more, that are offered to every human being on earth.

There are other benefits too.

A test region could be set up where volunteers could move to, where machines do all the work that machines are capable of doing.

Machines are actually capable of doing an astounding number of jobs with technology that is available now.

Redundant and unnecessary jobs can be eliminated, a lot of improvements are possible.

This test region would be similar to the biosphere project, except this is more of a social project.

In this region,  
the volunteers would work reduced hours,  
perhaps 15 hours a week,  
yet get more money than they did before  
with their regular job in conventional society.

This extra money comes from the increased efficiency of the machines, because machines work day and night without sleep and are therefore much more productive than a human.

Some of the extra money comes from the other improvements in society.

The test region could have all kinds of benefits including a higher standard of living, and more

time to socialize.

Once the test region is perfected and news gets out about how good things are there, a lot of other people will create more regions like it.

Some people may not realize how much technology exists today.

It really is possible to automate many jobs, and not just manufacturing either.

Do a little research into car manufacturing assembly lines. Many of them have been using robots for years now, to do welding and spray painting of new cars.

There is a remote controlled coal mining machine that is controlled by people above ground. This isn't fully automated since people still need to guide it with joysticks and watching on tv monitors, but it still prevents people from getting killed in the mines during cave ins and other disasters.

It is beyond the scope of this book to go into all the details.

You just need to realize that it really is possible right now to have machines do a lot of the work.

Naturally there will be disagreement on how to split up the money, and all the other details.

That is why there will be different regions, each region with its own way of doing things. People can pick which region they want.

When machines do most of the work, this frees up time

for people to concentrate on finding solutions to problems.

If millions of people worldwide can quit their boring jobs and still get money, then some of those people can now start working on medical research which will end up finding the cure to cancer and all other diseases, allowing people to live longer healthier lives.

Imagine if the average lifespan is 150 years, and all of it is good health, fun, and feeling better than you ever have before.  
Feeling better than you ever imagined possible.

The prosperity resulting from widespread machine labor could enable people to accomplish great things for humanity. And you can help make it happen by joining the alliance described in this book.

What will happen if we don't do as this book advocates? Today's trend will continue, job security will become more elusive all the time.

In the future, wages will go down.

You and/or your children will suffer the consequences.

Some people have difficulty imagining something based solely upon text. A picture is worth a thousand words anyway.

Lets talk about a movie, which although fictional, still graphically portrays the future we will have if trends continue as they have been.

The following movie graphically portrays the future: Freejack (1992) Starring Emilio Estevez and Mick Jagger.

Watch the movie and ask yourself if you want to be one of the poor class portrayed there, which has become the vast majority, or would you rather avoid that unpleasantness and have a nicer future for your children and grandchildren.

Do nothing and the future will be poor.  
That is the trend, the way things are heading.  
Join this books alliance and we can make it richer.

Life could be a wonderful time for everybody,  
like a carnival or a party,  
with machines doing the boring work,  
busy work being eliminated in favor of party time.

Anybody who is unfamiliar with busy work or the other topics discussed here should research it on their own, as this book cannot be an encyclopedia of all human knowledge.

This is a summary designed to get people thinking about improvements in what we jokingly call society.

### **Santa:**

Many people wait their entire lives for something good to happen to make their lives better.

In psychology this concept is known as  
"waiting for santa claus".

The problem with this is that santa is not coming to make your life fantastic.

You have to do something yourself to make it happen.

The alliance is your opportunity.  
don't let it pass.  
Join the team. Be a team player.

### **Stragglers:**

In case anybody remains unconvinced that work is best done by machines, lets remember that in many parts of the world today,  
children are being coerced into working long hours in unsafe conditions for meager pay, instead of being able to have access to a decent education for their future.

In many parts of the world today, children are exploited for cheap labor, and often get killed or severely injured in the process.

If you are unaware of the extent of the problem, perhaps you should take a little time and research it for yourself. You will be shocked by what you see. Many of the so called news media are completely ignoring this problem.

As with most of the worlds problems, children get the worst end of everything.  
This is of course inherently wrong.

Anybody with any consideration or decency would be incensed that these atrocities are ongoing, and would join the alliance proposed by this book, and work to end all these and other injustices.

## **Chapter 5:**

### **Regions.**

Regions are one of the most important keys to our success.

Regions, as used in this book, are sections of land that are a part of the alliance.

Typical society has 51% of the people wanting to do things one way, and the other 49% wanting to do it the other way. One side always loses, or there are compromises made where nobody wins.

Regions are important because they use different geographical areas to allow the 51% to live their way, and the other 49% to live their way, while both groups are still part of the team, the alliance.

In actuality, there will be more than 2 regions of course. There will likely be a thousand regions across all of earth in the future.

Regions are similar to countries, states, or provinces, except that all regions are equal parts of the alliance.

Regions are mostly like countries but the important difference is that all regions are part of one team, everybody is equal and can go to whatever region they want.

Regions may start small, but to be a full region it needs total local control.

Regions make their own regional laws, and the only other laws are those involving basic human rights, which the alliance will be responsible for.

Test regions can start out as a territory or protectorate of a country, but eventually full regions need to have total local control, so they don't have to suffer under unfair unwanted unnecessary harmful laws imposed on them from afar.

The only laws in regions are those that the people choose to have, in a democratic manner.

They also have to respect basic human rights of course, it is the alliances responsibility to enforce those, such as the right of people to move to another region should they choose to do so.

For example a region cannot bring back slavery, even if the majority approve, because that would violate basic human rights such as the right to move out.

All humans are equal in regions, so if somebody in one region changes their mind, they are always free to move to a different region.

Just like citizens of any country in the European Union are free to move to and work in any other country within the Union.

Just like citizens of the United States are free to move to and work in any State they choose.

Regions will start off small, but once fully implemented, their size will depend on the population.

If one region is popular and has a lot of people

wanting to move there, it gets more land.

An unpopular region shrinks in size.

Flexible borders are what we are talking about.

If a region has 1% of the worlds population wanting to live there, it gets 1% of the land on earth.

If a region has 3% of the worlds population wanting to live there, it gets 3% of the land on earth.

This way a popular region does not become overcrowded, and unpopular regions can't waste land that could be put to better use.

This system is inherently stable,  
as regions must compete with one another to get residents to live there.

Competition has been well proven in the free market system to provide better service to customers.

Now imagine competition of regions offering the absolute best standard of living for you and your family.

Your standard of living could go way up, the same as getting a huge pay raise.

If 2 regions have a dispute, the alliance will provide binding arbitration or other peaceful methods to settle it. War is never an option for regions.

Before anyplace can be considered a region, it must agree to that and other requirements set by the alliance.

Imagine if the whole world becomes regions in the future.

No more suffering, and prosperity for all.

Regions are different from countries in a number of ways.

While countries don't always work well together, all regions are always part of the same team, the alliance, thus they all work together like a team should.

All humans on earth are equal regardless of where they were born.

Any human can pick any region to live in, and move there, except as explained later.

Regions will start immediately but only in a few small areas where volunteers can live to test the system. Then regions will be very gradually expanded.

It will be phased in gradually so it will not cause any disruption in existing society.

The more volunteers who want to live in regions, the more regions will be built to accommodate them.

Nobody will be forced to move to a region.

Basically, regions are independent sections of earth that are all equal members of the alliance.

Regions are a new concept, similar to countries, but are a more advanced version of countries.

Regions are needed because people are different.

It is impossible to get all people on earth to live the same way, in some kind of monoculture.

Yet countries are not part of a team,  
they work against each other,  
restrict peoples movements across borders,  
and have many other problems.

Regions allow groups of people with similar  
lifestyles to live in one geographical area, while  
remaining part of a larger team, the alliance.

This way all humans are equal, help each other as  
groups, and live in peace on this planet,  
yet remain in different groups where each  
group can live as it sees fit.

**One example of region advantages:**

In typical society there are 2 or more  
groups living in one area.

One group may want to do one thing,  
while another group wants to do the opposite.

The typical society argues about it and eventually  
reaches some compromise that leaves both sides  
unhappy.

Or they go back and forth  
as different bureaucrats get elected.

Clearly that is not good for either side.

Regions solve this problem.

There can be one region that does things one way,  
people that want this can move there

and have exactly what they want.

Another region has the other way.

People who want this can move there and get exactly what they want.

Both sides win.

All people can pick which region they want to live in.

Since regions start out small, anybody who likes things the way they are now, can stay where they are now, and nothing changes for them.

Nobody has to move to a region if they don't want to.

Regions will be built on land which has not been developed yet, unless there is enough support to convert existing towns.

Regions may start about the size of a small province, or a city, or maybe a town, depending on the region, and the phase of development.

Regions can start small and gradually enlarge.

### **Country/regions:**

Another possibility, if there is enough support, then a whole country could become regions.

The government would pay moving expenses if anybody found themselves in the wrong region.

The country would become a number of regions. Since this is designed to start gradually then expand slowly to avoid any conflict, the regions would still be under the national laws, which would gradually be phased out in a slow and controlled manner, ending with different laws in each region as per the needs of the residents.

### **Reasons:**

One of the main reasons we need regions is because practically everywhere you go, a slight majority wants to do things one way and a significant part of the population wants a different way.

It is important to recognize the rights of the rest of the population that is not the majority.

It is also vital to remember that the majority is not always right. One of many examples is the now outdated law in the United States that made it illegal to help an escaped slave. The majority got the law passed, but that didn't make it right.

Note that the United States is not the only place that used to allow slavery. That is just being used as an example to make a point about majority rule.

You will find all kinds of problems all over the world, which is the reason we need to explore more efficient approaches to world politics.

Since the majority of the population is so similar everywhere you go, it is very difficult to establish a place where the rest of the population can live their way.

The alliance and its regions treat all humans equal regardless of where they were born.

**Similar example:**

Regions will work well.  
Look at examples of similar arrangements.

In the United States, each state maintains its own state government, and its own states national guard, yet works together with the other states as a team.

States never fight with each other, at least not in modern times.

The only thing wrong with the states arrangement is the federal system, which infringes on states rights. The feds make unconstitutional laws that take away freedom from the states.

An example was the prohibition against alcohol. As a federal law, it required all states to participate.

Yet, as well intentioned as it was, it was a disaster.

Eventually the prohibition (of alcohol) was repealed.

The fugitive slave law was also repealed.

Regions wont have a federal system hanging over its head, thus wont suffer from these problems.

The alliance only has basic human rights, things a person can do if they want, such as move out.

The alliance doesn't have the authority to impose restrictions on people, to take their freedom away.

This can never be changed.

Any restrictions can be done on a regional basis, so if the restrictions are unpopular then people can always move to a better region.

Of course people wont have to actually move.

Regions are like private companies, and know that they have to be nice to their customers or lose them. Problems will be averted prior to becoming a problem.

Going back to the prohibition example, if a region comes up with something as brain dead as a prohibition, most regions will decline to copy it.

So the only damage will take place in the region that came up with the stupid idea.

Thus damage is limited in the regional approach.

This is clearly a superior approach to global management.

One large group could become corrupted, but an alliance of smaller groups won't have that problem.

If one region becomes corrupt, the other regions are not affected, and since people will leave a corrupt region, its size will shrink, since its size depends on the number of people living there. So regions are inherently stable.

Any region with unresolved problems will quickly become a very small region or disappear completely and we won't be stuck with it anymore.

Of course this is not the sort of thing that you would expect to happen. Competition ensures high quality so you will see people wanting to move into regions, not the other way around.

Regarding teamwork, lately in the United States, the presidential elections show how the people are deeply divided. Almost half the people want one presidential candidate to win, and almost half want the other one to win. Yet when the mud slinging and election is over, everybody comes together as one team.

The same thing can happen with the alliance. As history has shown, it is possible for different people to overlook their differences and pull together as one team.

**Subdivisions:**

If a group of people want to form a region, but there are not enough people to form the region, then perhaps they can form a section of a region.

Regions can be subdivided into sections much like countries are divided into cities or provinces or other subdivisions.

This way all subdivisions can share a central hospital, dental facilities, and other necessities and utilities, while maintaining their own way of living.

The utilities should be located in the center of the region, with all subdivisions outside and around the center section.

This way everybody is equally close to the hospital and other necessities.

**Variety:**

There will be a good variety of regions on earth.

There will be at least one region that is perfect for any individual person.

If there are things you don't like about where you are now, you could even get together with other like minded people and form your own new region.

Everybody will be able to find a region that is perfect for them, or can make a region that is perfect for them.

This is real freedom, not the phony stuff that bureaucrats like to talk about while making more laws against virtually everything.

There could be Republican regions, Democrat regions, Libertarian regions, Socialist regions, and a whole lot of other regions and variations of regions.

There can be compromise regions that are just like existing society, for those people who don't want to change, where things go back and forth with every election.

### **Patents:**

There are no international patents possible.

Patents are strictly a regional thing.

The alliance can never impose any restrictions, it can only guarantee rights to those who want them.

This enables good regions to benefit from open source technology without being encumbered with broad patents that cover everything.

Everybody agrees that the patent system is broken, but there is no agreement on how to fix it.

Until now.

Hopefully, giving every region the freedom to use its own system will allow everybody to choose which region is right for them.

The default should be no patents, since there is really no idea that somebody else wont think of soon enough.

Open source is more effective.

The basic concept is that it is the right of the people to live as they see fit, in a democratic manner,  
therefore if half the world wants to live in open source regions then they have the right to do so. If the other half doesn't like it, then that's their problem.

## **Chapter 6:**

### **Exclusive regions**

In existing countries,  
rich people already live in their  
exclusive rich neighborhoods that nobody else can  
afford.

They have their exclusive clubs that the  
middle and poor classes  
are not allowed in, except as workers.

As used in this book,  
an exclusive region is one that excludes  
certain groups of people from living  
or visiting there.

Exclusive regions are not really much  
different than existing society,  
except that anybody who wants to live  
in an exclusive region will be able to  
find one that is right for them,  
and move to it if they want (once regions are  
implemented).

Some regions will let anybody in,  
other regions will be exclusive.  
Earth will have some of both types of regions.

All the people will decide by picking what  
type of region they want to live in.  
If half the people on earth want to live in exclusive

regions, then half the regions on earth will be exclusive.

Everybody that wants to be in an exclusive region will be in one.

This is truly a democratic system, unlike what we have today.

Any group of people can form an exclusive region and use whatever criteria they want to populate their region.

This enables people to exclude troublemakers.

One example of an exclusive region is one that requires an examination by a doctor and psychiatrist who works for the region.

A background check would also be performed, however bearing in mind the inaccuracy prevalent in many records, this is not automatic disqualification. Verification is required before denying somebody entrance to the region.

Anybody with a lengthy criminal history would be denied residence in this exclusive region.

If you don't like this, its no problem, there will be plenty of regions that let anybody in, you can live in one of those regions or stay where you are now.

There will likely be other types of exclusive regions too, that was just one example.

The important thing to remember is that one persons rights end where another persons rights begin.

This means that people have the right to live in an exclusive region with a much lower risk of them or their family being strangled, tortured, and killed by troublemakers.

Regions can be as exclusive as they want, provided they have enough responsible people to manage the region.

To prevent regions from excluding too many people, the size of the region will be directly linked to how many people choose to live there.

If a region has 1% of the worlds population, then it will get 1% of the land area on earth.

If they get very exclusive and have only a thousandth of a percent of the earths population, then they only get a thousandth of a percent of the earths land area.

This way it doesn't hurt anybody for a region to become super exclusive. If you are excluded, you can always start your own region with the other people who were excluded.

Everybody on earth will belong to one region, nobody is left out and nobody gets more than their fair share of the land area.

So this is infinitely more fair than the current system.

Remember that the current system is likely to

continue its trend of more and more regulations until nobody has any freedom.

The new system lets any group of people get together and form a region with their own rules or lack thereof, and live with all the freedom they want.

Exclusive regions allow people to enjoy freedom in freedom regions, and people who don't care about freedom can live in highly restrictive regions or stay where they are now.

**Fairness:**

Some people may say that it is not fair to exclude people in the exclusive regions.

But not all regions will be exclusive.

Also,

gated neighborhoods already exist before this book was written, they exclude people from living areas.

There are already a lot of examples of exclusive areas in your society and we haven't even made regions yet.

Frankly, most countries are already exclusive, they don't let immigrants come in without permission, and many countries are very exclusive about who they let in.

It is virtually impossible to get into some

countries, depending on your national origin and wealth.

Realistically, existing countries are more similar to the exclusive regions than countries are to the nonexclusive regions.

Few people have job security these days, at least in the jobs that somebody would actually want, thus many people are excluded from good jobs for no reason.

The main example of already existing exclusions are countries.

Most countries already exclude people based on place of birth, or economic status.

Countries are basically exclusive regions already, and we haven't even made regions yet.

Life is not fair.

What is especially unfair is when people are denied the ability to live in a region that has the level of freedom they want, and the ability to exclude people who don't fit in to that particular region.

People have rights, like it or not.

In particular, people have the right to live in a region that excludes troublemakers.

Troublemakers, like robbers, rapists, and murderers, are already jailed

after they hurt or kill somebody, if they get caught.

People have the right to live in a region that does background checks and psychological tests to screen out people before they hurt somebody.

Many governments already use psychological tests to screen out unsuitable candidates for certain jobs that involve a security clearance.

Not everybody will want to live in the exclusive regions.

But those who do want to live there, have the right to do so.

Peoples rights end where other peoples rights begin. Troublemakers rights end where good peoples rights begin.

In todays primitive societies, many people become victims of crime.

But in the advanced societies known as exclusive regions, people generally don't become victims of crime.

Which would you prefer?

Remember, the rest of us have just as much right to choose which type of region we want as anybody else. There will be plenty of types of regions so nobody is getting left out.

**Mini dictators:**

Anybody who is opposed to letting the rest of us have freedom in our own regions, our own islands of freedom, needs to realize that they do not own us. They are not mini dictators who can tell the rest of us what to do. We have rights, like it or not.

Any mini-dictator who attempts to stand in the way of freedom deserves to be ridiculed and shunned.

Only after wannabe dictators are shunned, will the rest of us be able to have freedom and a good life, and provide the same for the children, the future generations who will inherit this little planet when our time is over.

### **Land:**

In the beginning, there should be no major problems with land since there is a considerable amount of undeveloped land just waiting to be used. Some of it is reserved by existing governments but that can be changed. Regions will start out small then gradually enlarge, therefore this will not cause any real problems.

The United States federal government owns about 90% of the land in the State of Nevada.

Considerable other land all over earth is or can be made available.

### **Exception:**

Exclusive regions should not be able to discriminate based on religion.

If an exclusive region was allowed to form and allow only one religion in there, then the possibility exists that a holy war would happen at some point, with a neighboring region of different beliefs.

If there is a conflict between two religions then an exclusive region could exclude one of them, as long as all other religions are allowed. This is not ideal but hopefully in the future we can solve these problems.

It is possible for an Atheist region to be formed however, since Atheism is not a religion, but the lack of one.

Atheists have never started any holy wars, therefore there would be no trouble expected in the Atheist regions.

## **Chapter 7:**

### **The alliance.**

The alliance is responsible for ensuring that no region can ever violate anybody's human rights.

Even though each region is independently managed, all regions are still required to abide by basic human rights such as the right to leave the region.

Other responsibilities of the alliance include the arbitration of disputes between regions, because wars between regions are not an option.

Regions must agree to settle disputes peacefully or else they cannot become regions.

Countries use wars to settle disputes because they lack an effective method of settling disputes.

The United Nations is completely useless in that regard.

The United Nations is not a democratic organization since nobody gets to vote to elect people in it.

The alliance consists of all people who have joined it, and the same thing for regions, it is a team.

To join this team, people have to agree to use civilized methods to settle disputes.

Since the alliance represents all people equally, and is a democratic organization, it will have the neutrality and respect needed

to be an effective solution to world problems.

You never get to vote in the United Nations.

But the alliance consists of all people who wish to join it.

Thus the alliance is a democratic organization unlike the United Nations.

Note:

once this book comes out, the United Nations might actually allow some limited voting, as a response to the criticism. Unfortunately for all of us, the United Nations will still be taking freedom away, and will not become fully democratic. Any changes they make will be very limited, they are just throwing us a bone.

**Distinction:**

The alliance starts when all the groups join together to form the alliance.

Once regions form, a branch of the alliance will need to be formed to take care of the alliances responsibilities regarding regions.

This branch will need to consist of people who have the ability and time to do this very important job.

We cannot hold a global election to decide the outcome of every dispute between regions.

These matters need to be decided by people who are educated in such matters, and who can be trusted to

do a good job.

It is suggested that a global election be held to elect representatives to the different branches of the alliance.

The elected representatives would then use the consensus method to proceed with settling disputes.

In the event a consensus cannot be obtained, then each region will be free to do as it wishes.

Freedom decides any ties.

In other words, if there is a dispute about how to proceed, and no consensus is possible, then each region has the freedom to do as it wishes in its own territory. Freedom has the last word.

Freedom wins.

### **Consensus vs. majority rule:**

The alliance is not majority rule.

The majority make too many mistakes.

Majorities have voted into power such things as slavery.

Those mistakes will not be repeated with this alliance.

The alliance is simply a team where each member lives in their own region, and does their own thing, and leaves the other members alone.

It is like an agreement for independence yet having

mutual assistance when requested.

The alliance will never be allowed to make global laws that take away any freedom from all regions. An example would be the fugitive slave law that made it a crime to help an escaped slave. The alliance does not have the authority to take away peoples rights, even if the majority wish it.

Therefore the alliance can never make it illegal to help somebody, and this can never be changed.

Another example was the prohibition of alcohol. These laws take away the freedom to do something, and will never be tolerated in the alliance.

The alliance exists to give people freedom and choices, not to take freedom away from people. If a law is necessary then a region can implement it on its own. If some people don't like the law then there are other regions which lack the law, therefore freedom now exists for all people on earth.

Majorities have voted into power such things as slavery.

Those mistakes will not be repeated with this alliance.

This alliance exists primarily to enforce the rights of all humans, not just some of them.

Hence no majority rule.

### **Formation:**

The formation of the alliance needs to have an orderly process with no ambiguity.

A copy of this book must be kept as a reference to

any founding documents of the alliance.

To become a member of the alliance, a group needs to agree to the following points. There are no exceptions.

Any group that refuses any part of this list will not be a part of the alliance.

Everybody who is in the alliance must agree to exclude anybody who refuses to agree to this list.

Failure to do it this way would result in a disorganized mess similar to the state of world affairs today, and that must be avoided.

1.

Freedom is the top priority of the alliance.

Any region can do as it wishes within its own borders, regarding informed adults, as long as it respects basic human rights such as the right to leave a region.

This means that if a freedom region wishes to allow adults to do some activity within its own borders, that some other region disapproves of, then the anti-freedom regions or the alliance cannot do anything about it.

If some freedom haters dont like freedom, thats fine, but they cant force their views on anybody else.

The alliance can never, repeat never, make global laws that restrict freedom over the entire planet.

For example a global prohibition of alcohol or marijuana can never happen.

If somebody doesn't like alcohol then they have the option of living in a region that bans alcohol, but they can't take away other peoples freedom in other regions.

This cannot be abused by coercing every region to make the same laws, which has the same end result of banning something from the whole earth. As long as there are a group of adults who wish to exercise a particular freedom, then there should be a region where that freedom is allowed. If somebody doesn't like it then thats their problem. Other people have rights too.

Neither the alliance nor any other group or government can force any kind of global patent laws. The best regions will likely be open source regions, and they cannot be burdened by broad patents that cover everything, and restrict growth.

2.

if there are no freedom regions in existence that allow some particular freedom, yet there are a group of people who wish to exercise that freedom, then the group has the right to form a new region where that particular freedom is allowed.

They must be given a percentage of the land that is proportional to their population.

Thus if 3% of the worlds population wants to form a freedom region, then they can, and they are allotted 3% of the worlds land to do so.

The alliance can handle details such as the exact geographical location of the land.

The region would need to start small and gradually

expand so there are no problems with implementation.

A region may need a certain minimum size but this cannot be abused to deny people freedom.

A section of a region can be used for small groups.

3.

Regions are all part of a team, the alliance.

This means that if one region comes under attack by a rogue country or any other group, then all regions are obligated to assist the region being attacked.

Regions are a team, and protect each other just like the States in the United States all work together as a team.

Note that it is unlikely anybody would ever attack a region, knowing it would be certain to fail because the whole world would be against them.

For the first time in history, the whole world would be a team, the alliance, standing up for each others rights and freedoms.

Yet each region is still independently owned and operated, thus we have the benefits of decentralization and competition.

4.

People cannot be tricked out of their rights.

There should be a series of default regions, also known as freedom regions, that are recommended for new people, new adults getting started in life.

Before being allowed to go to any region that restricts freedom, somebody should have to read and sign a document that clearly explains they are giving

up rights.

Every child on earth should be educated as to the rights they can have in the freedom regions, if they should choose to live in a freedom region upon growing up.

5.

The world cannot be run by committee.

Only an idiot would try to run the world by committee.

No group, or even the majority, may add in their own agenda here and try to force it on the rest of the world. That would fail because the rest of the world would refuse to go along with it.

We need this to work, because the future generations are depending on us to leave them a better world than we have today.

Thus, if something is troubling you, make your own region with like minded people where you can live your way in your region, but dont try to force it on the rest of us.

### **Details:**

There are a lot of details involved in running regions, but those are not the responsibility of the alliance.

The vast majority of details regarding regions are handled at the regional level by the region itself.

The alliance only steps in when there is a dispute

between 2 regions, or if a region is trying to trap people there, not letting them leave, or similar situations.

The easiest way to think of the alliance is that it is a democratic version of the United Nations that only enforces basic human rights, and never restricts freedom from anybody.

It is very important to remember that the alliance cannot ever make global laws that restrict freedom.

The alliance cannot ever take away somebody's right to do something, it only offers rights to those who want them. This cannot ever be changed, and it is considered an act of treason to suggest it.

For example, if somebody doesn't like alcohol, there will probably be one or more regions that ban alcohol. They could move there and be happy.

If they try to get the alliance to ban alcohol over the whole earth, that is an act of treason since the alliance only offers rights, it doesn't take them away.

That is one of the most important differences between the alliance and the United Nations.

For anybody who doesn't know, the United Nations is currently pushing all kinds of treaties that coerce countries to make certain things illegal.

If this is allowed to continue, all countries would eventually be affected, with the result that it would be illegal over the whole earth, and there would be no place to go with freedom from that unwanted and harmful law.

### **Health and fun:**

Another branch of the alliance will be responsible for researching the best ways to treat and prevent medical problems, or maintain the best health, or have the most fun.

It will then distribute this information via the web to anybody who wishes to benefit from it.

Of course regions are also free to educate their residents, and there are a lot of benefits to decentralization.

But there should be a central point where this information is available, since some regions will be small and may not have the resources to fully explore the issues.

### **To recap:**

The alliance is not a government of earth.

The alliance can never impose anything on anybody against their will.

The alliance only offers human rights to anybody who

wants them, and makes sure everybody knows these rights. It also acts as an arbitrator to prevent regions from having wars with each other.

The alliance only does good things, it never restricts peoples freedom such as making laws against anything.

An example would be the fugitive slave law that made it illegal to help an escaped slave.

That took freedom away from people, and is an example of something the alliance could never do.

Regions are responsible for any restrictions that may be desirable within their territory.

Any laws restricting freedom, such as a prohibition against alcohol, are only possible on a regional basis.

The alliance cannot impose restrictions on anybody's freedom, and this cannot ever be changed, not during crisis, national emergencies, or any other excuses.

It is not possible to change this in the future, and suggesting it is considered an act of treason. Treason will be severely punished.

By the way, there will be no slavery in any regions.

### **Future problem:**

One possible problem we must avoid in the future is the concept that some rich selfish person could get the same law passed in every single region on earth. Then there would be no place left with freedom from

this law.

The filthy rich people have enough resources to pull tricks like this on us.

This has the effect of undermining freedom.

Freedom is good, and is worth working for.

As long as there is any group which feels the law is unnecessary, then there should be at least one region on earth where the law does not exist.

That way the group(s) can live in that region with freedom.

We do need to take steps to ensure that nobody can undermine our freedom by getting some law passed in every single region, or even a lot of them.

The default (freedom) regions should have checks and balances run by the people, to ensure that the only laws are those that the people really want and need.

It should be difficult and time consuming to get a law passed, so they can't sneak laws in without our knowledge or consent as we are busy with our lives and don't have time to watch the bureaucrats all day.

The freedom regions would only allow laws that get approved by lawmakers, then a year or so of time for debate, then approval for constitutionality by an accountable supreme court, and finally pass a vote by

the entire population. Only then would a law go into effect.

No sneaky tricks allowed, such as attaching a law to another must-pass one, or a group of them, so we are forced to choose between all or none. Every law is considered individually.

## **Chapter 8:**

### **The injustice system.**

#### **Children of the injustice system:**

Some countries hold children in jail for extended periods of time, just because they were accused of a crime.

It doesn't seem to matter if they actually did the crime or not. An accusation is all it takes.

In some of these countries children are placed in overcrowded cells with adult prisoners, where all kinds of abuse follows.

One of the goals of the alliance is basic human rights to stop this practice and ensure that it is never restarted.

#### **Disclaimer:**

Lets take a moment to say that not everybody who works in the injustice system is causing it to be an injustice.

Some employees are very good, taking personal risks to try to help people.

The purpose of this article is to point out what is wrong with the system, and the few bad employees who give the others a bad name, and most importantly, how to fix the system.

This article concentrates on the bad things, but it should be noted that the system does some good things too. That does not mean we must take

the bad with the good.

Much like a water filter, we can dump the bad and keep the good.

Some employees of the system, like judges and police officers, have spoken out against the war on drugs and civil liberties. They advocate fixing the broken system, so this article is not picking on the good people, it is picking on the few bad ones and the system as a monopoly.

### **Introduction:**

The injustice system is worse in some areas than others, but it is spreading, so even if your area is not too bad yet, it wont stay that way for long. It is not a good idea to blow off this chapter just because your area is not affected yet.

There are examples of how the injustice is already spreading to other countries. We can fix these problems if we get busy now.

Like many things in this book, the injustice system has probably not been a problem for you, yet.

That is unless you consider all the money it wastes, and the fact that your taxes are higher because of that wasted money. You could get a lot more money back if we fix the system. Before you think it wont affect your area or anybody you care about, read the whole chapter.

Many people are under the impression that the system just picks up criminals.

Unfortunately there are a large number of totally innocent people, these are people with families and professional jobs, who get arrested by mistake or

similar reasons and imprisoned, sometimes for decades. You could be next if we don't fix the system while we have the chance.

In some areas, when DNA evidence started to be used, the news was full of stories practically every day, of yet another person being released from prison after 20 years, when DNA showed the person could not have possibly been the person who did the crime.

In other cases, the person who really did it confessed so they had to let the innocent person out of prison where he was for 20 years.

### **The beginning:**

The injustice system did not start out bad.

The bureaucrats came under a lot of pressure to provide jobs for the people.

Building and staffing prisons creates tons of jobs.

Some areas have already seen competition for which town gets the new prison.

The bureaucrats make a number of unconstitutional laws to ensure the police have plenty of reasons to arrest people and fill the jails.

Then the bureaucrats come out looking good because the unemployment rate has decreased.

Good for them.

Now watch your back because you might be the next person to go to that jail.

New laws get passed all the time and they don't call you to let you know about it.

You may be surprised to find out how many different things can result in your going to jail, even though you were not doing anything wrong.

In many parts of the world, you can even go to jail for getting into a car accident, even if it wasn't your fault, even if no speeding or drinking alcohol was involved.

What part of the word "accident" can't they understand?

True you don't always go to jail for accidents, but many people do and you could be next, especially if the other driver injures himself when he runs into you. There were, and are, better ways to provide jobs.

Some localities actually imprison people when one of their relatives does something illegal.

One example of this is the recent laws that punish parents for the acts of their children.

This may be well intentioned but is totally unfair when parents make good faith efforts to bring up the children properly, but they go astray anyway.

### **Even more ways to get imprisoned:**

In the year 2005 the European Commission was pushing a directive that would put computer programmers in jail if the computer program they write is used to share copyrighted files.

This is not just file sharing programs, laws are

already being written that apply to office network programs.

Since programs are perfectly legal when used as intended on files that are not copyrighted, this directive makes a programmer risk jail even though he did not intend the program to be used for illegal activity.

This is like putting a car designer in jail if somebody drives carelessly and gets in a crash. Maybe the injustice system will start doing that next.

It is yet another example of the injustice system being out of control.

The injustice system is also known as the prison industrial complex. It is a thriving and profitable business that hurts a lot of people and breaks up families so a few people can profit from it.

### **Changes:**

Before anybody thinks the "justice" system is not that bad, lets discuss how its changes will affect people, possibly including you, in the near future.

In some places, they have already started arresting and holding people without charge.

Things always start off small then gradually get larger and worse. Once people become accustomed to holding people without charges on the serious "charges", if you can call it charges considering they haven't been charged, then it will be expanded

to other charges.

Before long, there will be no bail for any accusations.

They will just arrest your children and hold them without bail indefinitely. Is this what you want the future to look like?

### **Expansion:**

Argentina has doubled its incarceration rate around the time this book was written.

Many other countries are preparing or in the process of doing the same thing. This is going to be especially serious in countries that are puppets of larger countries.

If the injustice system is not bad in your area yet, be careful, your good luck may not last too long.

Another consideration is that it may be bad in your area but you are not yet aware of it. This may change if you become its next victim.

### **Malicious prosecution:**

One classic example of this kind of harassment was when a hacker discovered a security weakness in a wireless network at a court, and demonstrated to the court employees how easy it was to break into the network.

Nobody was harmed by this, and indeed the exposure of the problem could lead to the security hole being

fixed before private records were accessed by some identity thief.

So the hacker did some good for the people.

And the court prosecuted him for it.

He faced 10 years in prison.

Fortunately he was acquitted, but it was still a costly and disturbing process to be prosecuted.

This is the sort of thing that the injustice system must be prevented from doing ever again.

It is an injustice when the injustice system knows it cannot get a conviction, often because nobody has been harmed, yet the injustice system decides to prosecute anyway.

This costs the defendant a huge amount of money for a lawyer and expenses, and a huge amount of time that could be better spent elsewhere.

It is also a nerve wracking experience.

This is known as malicious prosecution.

There is no downside from the governments point of view.

There is nothing the victim of this prosecution can do about it.

It is essentially impossible to prove malicious prosecution in most courts because there are few, if any, checks and balances.

There is no realistic way for citizens

to control the injustice system.

The government does not reimburse the victim of the prosecution for all the time and money that was lost.

It is just a way for the injustice system to hurt somebody and get away with it.

It is a travesty of justice that this is allowed to happen with little or no recourse.

Many places give absolute immunity to prosecutors.

This means that even if you have proof the prosecutor acted maliciously, the prosecutor still has immunity from criminal charges and cannot be sued either.

If we had a fair system, and a prosecutor did something illegal, then the prosecutor could be charged with criminal offenses, or at least sued.

But the system we have gives immunity to prosecutors so they don't have to bother following the laws that the rest of us second class citizens are obligated to.

### **Incompetence:**

As the news has reported on more than one occasion, government labs have botched the analysis of evidence, resulting in innocent people going to prison for an extended period of time.

People deserve better than this.

Well, some people do.

Regions would allow private companies to compete with all aspects of the government.

Competition works well with the post office.

Originally the postal service had little or no competition. If you wanted to send something by express delivery, forget it, it wasn't an option.

Then a number of private shipping and overnight letter services like FedEx, UPS, and a host of other delivery services started providing competition.

So the postal service improved its service and started offering express services and tracking of shipments.

Competition made the government improve its service.

Competition results in better service to people than a government monopoly. There is no reason that we should not benefit from competition in all areas of our lives, not just shipping services.

### **Cruel and unusual punishment:**

As if we have not covered enough atrocities yet, there's more.

Whenever the system wants to do some injustice to its people, it usually phases it in gradually. They want you to get used to it before they start doing it more often. This way there is less complaining, and it is spread out over a longer time period, thus is easier for the bureaucrats to implement.

One example is castrating sex offenders. They start by only castrating the worst offenders who commit the most horrible offenses.

Then later they start castrating more offenders who have committed lesser offenses.

This is the point we are at right now in many parts of the world.

Later, if the trend continues as it has, they will start doing this cruel punishment to first time offenders for the most questionable crimes.

As we have already noticed, the injustice system has wrongfully convicted and even executed innocent people on many occasions. Do we really want to start castrating innocent people too?

Whats next, are we going to start cutting the hands off your kids if they get accused of stealing a candy bar?

What if they wrongfully castrate your son or grandson? How would you feel about it then?

When the system falsely imprisons somebody for 20 years before realizing the mistake, at least they can let the person go back to whats left of his life.

But mutilating somebody negates the chance of ever having a good life. When a person is sterilized he can never have a family. There are also a lot of feelings involved.

This barbarism must be stopped if we are to become a civilized society.

There are far better ways of dealing with, and preventing, crime.

Cruel sadistic punishments or "treatments" are not the answer.

It would be more humane to offer the prisoner capital punishment. That would have a lower risk of recidivism, and the prisoner would no longer be suffering.

In fact, statistics show that nobody has ever committed another crime after being executed.

This publication does not actually advocate capital punishment. This is for making a point.

Some people do not get much enjoyment from sex, and therefore have difficulty understanding how wrong it is to deprive some innocent person of their ability to have and enjoy sex.

Taking away sex, which is often the greatest pleasure of a persons life, from some innocent person by mistake, is completely unacceptable in a civilized society.

Much like some people are stronger or smarter than others, some people get a lot more pleasure from sex than others.

Not all people are the same.

Lets expand on the differences people have.

This may be a shock to some people, but people are different. Some people have a larger number of nerve cells than others. This is a physical difference which has been observed during autopsies.

Much like intelligence or strength, pleasure has all

kinds of variations between the extremes.

Its not all or nothing.

The point of all this is that even if some readers are not experiencing much pleasure, they need to understand that other people do experience a lot of pleasure, and therefore it is wrong to castrate innocent people by mistake.

Even if we could be certain that the person was guilty, it would still be wrong to castrate him, although we could of course confine him to protect the public.

For anybody who doesn't know, castration is sterilization.

If you want to return to the old days of eugenics, why not do it right and sterilize the bureaucrats instead?

Note that when an innocent person is punished this way by the injustice system, and later found to be innocent, this surgery cannot be undone.

It is permanent.

Every time the system imprisons an innocent person for decades then discovers the mistake and lets them go, at least they are intact.

But sterilizing somebody is permanent, so if it is done by mistake then it is much more serious. Anybody who lacks the intellectual capacity to comprehend how wrong it is to castrate somebody against their will, should be

imprisoned. We don't need people like that in any society.

When we talk about castration being done against the persons will, we include plea deals where the person agrees to it because realistically, this is coerced by the horrible conditions in the overcrowded prisons. The person may be agreeing to it technically, but it is really coerced by the inhumane conditions.

The injustice system is not above using dirty tricks to get what it wants. For example the system may get somebody to sign consent for the surgery to take place at some later date, knowing that it is so far in the future that it is easier to get the person to sign. Then as the date approaches and the person changes his mind, the injustice system refuses to allow the person to withdraw consent.

The systems plan comes to its conclusion.

### **Plea bargains:**

Another thing the injustice system likes to do is offer a person a drastically reduced sentence if he admits guilt. They threaten him with a long prison sentence if he doesn't.

While this may save the court some work when the person is actually guilty, it has drawbacks.

One drawback is when the person is innocent, but doesn't know if he can prove his innocence, and is afraid of being incarcerated for a huge amount of time.

The person is often coerced by the threat of long imprisonment in prisons with horrible conditions and overcrowding, and pleads guilty just to get out faster.

Bear in mind that not everybody can afford bail, and the injustice system usually holds people in jail before the trial, in other words treating him as guilty until proven innocent.

Naturally some people are not even offered bail anyway.

So he is already in jail and can see what its going to be like. Prison conditions in many countries are so bad that it is tantamount to torture.

### **Privatization:**

A private company would never be able to get away with abusing its customers the way the governments injustice system gets away with abusing its people, assuming there is suitable competition.

The government gets away with it because there is no choice for the people, there is only one government monopoly.

Even moving to another state or province doesn't get out of the jurisdiction of the federal or national laws.

Even moving to another country doesn't get away from the international treaties that every country on earth gets coerced into signing, this is becoming a greater problem as time goes on.

Not that its always allowed to move to another country, many countries are very restrictive in this regard.

But if we use regions, with some permanently allowing some things, and other regions restricting them, everybody can vote with their feet and move to a better region.

The autonomy of the regions means they are not bound by the corrupt United Nations treaties.

This gets around the unconstitutional international treaties.

Some regions will have private companies instead of governments.

Private companies can't abuse their customers because they will go with a better company.

Abusive companies would quickly go out of business as word spreads. This gets around the problem of police brutality and related problems.

Right now, the only people who really like the injustice system are those who don't know much about anything, or those who are making their living from the injustice system. Anybody who knows anything about anything, and has a better source of income, would be utterly disgusted with the injustice system.

Competition will result in much better service to the people (the customers) and would also be better to work for. Don't believe it? How much higher is the pay for the private security guards who watch the celebrities?

How many private guards get killed watching celebrities, compared with police officers?

Face it, privatized security would be better to work for and to be served by.

Everybody would benefit if the police were privatized, including the police officers themselves, as the next chapter shows.

## **Chapter 9:**

### **Private security**

The word "privatization" is sometimes used to refer to a government function being transferred to a private company.

But if there is only one company, then there is no competition, and we are often worse off than before.

This book refers to privatization as when a NUMBER of private companies compete to offer the people a choice. That is competition and results in better service to the people.

Even though most police officers do an excellent job, there are some who are not so good.

Since there is no competition, all police work for the government, it is not possible to get the level of service that would be provided by a private company.

We need competition.

Competition results in better service to us because the bad providers go out of business and we aren't stuck with them anymore.

Many regions should privatize the police.

The police would be replaced by private security officers working for different competing companies.

The security officers would do the same job as the

police, but do it better since private companies are more efficient than government, and competition gives better service.

This way there would be a drastic reduction or even elimination of police brutality and misconduct.

If private security officers replaced the police, then different security companies could compete against each other. The best companies would stay in business and the incompetent or cruel ones would go bankrupt.

The present system floods police officers with paperwork and inefficient procedures, and makes them enforce certain petty things for political reasons, while serious crimes sometimes go unpunished.

Most of the same people now working as police officers will be the employees of the private security companies.

So its not like we will have inexperienced people working for the private companies.

How this is implemented can vary by region.

Some regions can be subdivided, much like countries are divided into provinces or states, or counties and towns.

One company can have one section, another company can have another section. People can vote with their feet and live in the section that has the best company to suit their needs. As companies get more or less business, the borders of the sections can be adjusted to equalize the amount of land.

It probably wont require much adjustment after the initial period. Commercial companies know that they

need to take good care of their customers to stay in business.

When was the last time you saw a private security officer at a store beating up a customer?

A store that did that wouldn't stay in business for very long, once word got out.

It is a well established fact that competition leads to better service. Competition is good, monopolies are bad.

Concerned about who is going to pay for the private security companies? You are already paying for the police in taxes, that same money can be used for the private companies.

It will probably cost less since private companies are generally more efficient than monopolies.

That means you will get more money back in taxes.

The disadvantage that usually afflicts private companies is that many people cant afford them. To solve this, perhaps we can have everybody select the company of their choice, then the government pays that company on your behalf, by using the same tax money they would have given to the police government monopoly.

This way everybody gets to pick a company, nobody gets left out. And the crappy companies will get no customers, go out of business, and we wont be stuck with them anymore.

This is competition,  
one of the hallmarks of a real democracy.

There can still be minimum training standards that security officers must pass prior to beginning work, so the training remains the same as it is now with the police.

The minimum wage for security officers can match the pay the police now receive, so low pay will not become a problem, at least not any more than it already is.

The fact is, private companies may end up being significantly better both to work for and to be served by.

If somebody is arrested, they are taken to the private security company that they selected, and processed there.

This way they get a choice, instead of one monopoly run by the government. Each company maintains its own prisons and its own security officers that do the job of the police officers.

If we privatize the system, you will see the level of service go way up, along with the way everybody is treated.

Presumably there will be a degree of cooperation between companies to maximize the service delivered to the customers. It should be mandatory.

So if one company sees a drunk driver, they will stop the car and find out what company the driver has selected.

If the driver has selected a different company than the one stopping the car, then the driver has the option of requesting the selected company send an officer to take over the case.

This book is not intended to go into every detail,

but you get the general idea. Details will likely vary by region.

Regions could be subdivided and one company gets each section so people can stay in region yet still move to a section of their choice and get service from that company.

The government can stay in the business if they want. The post office still stays in business even though email, UPS, FedEx, and other private shipping companies are competing with them.

This way we will see a huge increase in the level of service provided by the government.

The same thing happened with the post office, which originally did not have express letter services until overnight delivery private companies started taking away some of their business.

Competition is good,  
and it is not what we have now.

Well, rich people hire their own private bodyguards, but that doesn't seem to apply to us second class citizens who cant afford them.

Since there will likely be a large number of regions on earth, perhaps even a thousand or more, maybe some regions can have a single company policing the entire region, instead of a number of companies.

By limiting what people can be arrested for, in other words getting rid of all the unconstitutional laws, everything may work just fine. Competition will exist in the form of some people moving to a better region in the event of problems, thus decreasing the

incentive to provide poor service. Losing paying customers is always a cause for concern in business, and tends to keep them working well.

If all people are equal and can pick any region to live in, then there is real competition which results in a higher standard of living.

Note that people wont actually have to move, since service will go up everywhere as a result of the competition.

Worried that service may decline?

Highly unlikely, but if you are concerned, stay with the police. As long as people have the choice between conventional police and private companies, everybody can have exactly what they want. Freedom is good, lack of it is bad. Some towns or regions can stay with the government model, instead of privatizing, things will stay exactly as they are, for those who want to live there.

### **Employee benefits:**

Some people may be worried that private companies would not offer the same vacation time or other benefits to the privatized police officers as the government police now get.

Well, thats what the rest of us have to live with all our lives as we work for private companies.

The solution is not to give police the special benefits, and let all the second class citizens, you know, the taxpayers, go without.

The correct solution would be to give all private

company employees, whether in police or other jobs, the same benefits that the police now get. That would be fair.

Unfair is to treat the taxpayers as second class citizens, and give all kinds of special privileges to the police, as they now get.

In current society, the police have many special privileges not granted to the taxpayers. It seems that working for the government elevates a person above the rest of us.

The special privileges vary by country, you can look up details in your area.

#### **Existing privatization:**

It should be noted that some areas are already privatizing prisons. They do this by giving a private company a contract to run a prison, instead of having the government run it.

They do this to save money, not to give inmates better rehabilitation or living conditions.

Inmates don't have any choice as to which prison to go to.

That is not real privatization.

This is not the system this book is advocating.

The book advocates giving people a choice, not just inmates but all people.

#### **Existing country choices:**

Some people already have the choice to move to another country.

Indeed it is true that some countries have a much higher incarceration rate and police brutality rate than other countries.

So why does the book advocate the privatization changes?

One reason is that not everybody can afford to move to a better country. Many people are living below the poverty level due to the horrible low pay rates so prevalent in the world.

Another reason is that the world is slowly devolving into some sort of monoculture where United Nations treaties set the rules for every country on earth.

It won't be long before moving to a better country is no longer an option, even for those who currently have the option.

### **Employee benefits:**

Police officers would be better off if the police department was privatized, because then they won't have to enforce unwanted and harmful laws against the people.

Sometimes they get harmed or killed in the process of enforcing those unwanted laws.

But in regions, the only laws there are the ones the people actually want. Anybody who doesn't like the laws there could simply move to a different region that lacks that law.

This is clearly a superior approach, compared to the present system of forcing laws on everybody whether

they like it or not, after the majority or even just a plurality managed to get the law passed.

With regions, the police/security don't have to enforce petty laws for political reasons.

**Region benefits:**

If we implement regions, then some regions will be run by private companies, and some of those will offer to pay moving expenses to get people to move there.

Just like some employers pay expenses and offer a hiring bonus.

These are the benefits of private companies over the way we do things today with the government monopoly.

Competition and private companies offer a much higher standard of living compared to monopolies.

Some regions would likely privatize everything that is currently done by government, not just security/police.

In other words, private companies would run the region instead of a government. They would of course still be required to abide by basic human rights and all that, but instead of a government there would be a corporate structure which needs to cater to its customers,

the residents.

Bureaucrats often only look ahead as far as the next

election, since that's what concerns them.

This is bad for your children/grandchildren because we need long term planning.

Private companies would be more suitable for looking ahead farther than the next election, since the people running the company aren't concerned about being elected.

Just imagine the benefits you could get.

Remember, private security is what rich celebrities use.

Why do the rich celebrities use private security?

Because it's the best.

## Chapter 10:

### Pharmaceutical industry.

The drug war probably hasn't affected you, yet, but that may change with the latest escalation in the war.

They are developing new pharmaceuticals that were intended to help drug addicts break their addiction. These

medications take away some of the "high" that drug users get, thus reducing the incentive to use drugs and making it easier to quit using drugs.

When used for its intended purpose, this may be good, depending on side effects, i.e.

If it kills some of the patients. But it won't be long before many people who don't even use drugs will be coerced into taking this medication, in an attempt to prevent them from using drugs in the first place. Later we may find side effects like flipper babies or some even more hideous as yet unknown side effects.

This is a violation of people's rights to not have to take medication against their will, especially unnecessary medication.

The pharmaceutical industry makes a huge amount of profit and would love to make more by pushing this medication.

If you don't believe the government would impose medication on people against their will, then there are plenty of examples in history, where the government imposes its will on its people.

The draft, wars, the fiasco known as the prohibition of alcohol, and the confiscation of cash from people who are not drug smugglers, are only some of the examples. It varies depending on which country you are in, but all governments have a long history of doing what they want to you. And its only getting worse.

If it has not come to your area yet, your luck may be short lived. Even if the government doesn't impose it, private companies will. Some already force employees to pee in a jar for drug testing. Is it really that far fetched that they would force medication next?

Schools may jump into this too, many of them already deprive students of their right to freedom from unreasonable searches. Families receiving public assistance may be required to submit to these medications.

Note that they wont call it what it is.

In keeping with their misrepresentations, they will refer to it much like a vaccination. People will not even know the full extent of what they are being subjected to.

Some governments are starting to give immunity from lawsuits to pharmaceutical companies, so they can avoid having to be sued when their medications hurt people. This is yet another outrage, how the system is hurting the people and not being held accountable.

Another item of concern regarding drug testing is the false positives. This is when somebody isn't using drugs, but the test was inaccurate and says they did.

A lot of people have been fired for this. This is so blatantly unfair, and is yet another reason we need to change the system to get the injustice out of it.

### **Ablating the nucleus accumbens:**

Note that ablation is the surgical destruction or removal of part of the body.

The nucleus accumbens is part of the brain.

Some groups are genuinely opposed to the use of drugs and are doing horrible things. See the med usenet newsgroup for a discussion of this.

At least one country has started doing experimental surgery on people to surgically destroy part of the brain that is basically the pleasure center of the brain, in an attempt to keep the person from having any pleasure from drugs, or presumably from having any other pleasure either.

This is an attempt to keep people from using drugs.

How does one begin to describe such an atrocity?

Is this what the world is coming to?

Have they learned nothing from the lobotomy fiasco?

As we will see later in the book, the United Nations is making all kinds of global treaties that affect people anywhere on earth.

The United Nations is slowly becoming a one world federal government that makes restrictions and laws that apply everywhere, in the form of international treaties.

If that is allowed to happen, we will see this kind of experimental surgery performed in your country too.

Of course they may not call it experimental for much longer, once they have done the surgery to more people than they already have, it will become a standard procedure. Is this what you want your children to be subjected to? We need to make an alliance to stop this and other atrocities while we still can.

Even if there is only a minimal risk of earth ending up with these atrocities taking place, we must act now to stop it. The risks are too great to just hope for the

best. Hope is great but it doesn't accomplish anything.

Bear in mind that new surgical techniques allow fast operations that could be performed on large numbers of people.

## **Chapter 11:**

### **Basic human rights.**

Who this applies to:

all humans regardless of what country or region they were born in, where they currently live, their race, sex, religion, etc. in other words, everybody. When space stations and space travel become commonplace, it applies to everybody there too. Everybody, everywhere, no exceptions.

These are human rights that apply to anybody who wants them, regardless of any other details.

These rights basically give anybody the right to move to any region they want, and to be informed of these rights.

Individual regions are encouraged to make additional rights that apply to people in that particular region.

This list of basic rights is minimal because it needs to be something that the whole world can agree on.

Everybody is different, it would be impossible to make a complete list of rights that everybody would agree on.

Thus these basic rights cover every human on earth, giving them rights such as the ability to go to a region of their choice. Once in the region of their choice, they will have a set of rights that is perfect for them.

These basic rights ensure that everybody grows up with the knowledge needed to make an informed

decision on how to live that will suit them. Then they can move to a region that has more rights.

Each region will have its own rights that suit the people living there, without causing conflict with people in other regions who want to have different rights.

For example, it would be impossible to find a compromise on gun rights that would suit everybody.

If you ban guns, then everybody who wants freedom won't like it. If you allow guns, then everybody who hates guns won't like it. A compromise would leave most people in both groups wanting something different.

But having different regions, some allowing guns and some not, plus some regions allowing guns with various restrictions, will allow everybody to live in a region perfect for them. Everybody wins.

Islands or continents can be used as a natural barrier to insulate different regions from one another.

In other words, one island can be a region where guns are allowed, another island can be where they are banned.

The navy can patrol the waters between regions to keep people from coming into another region without permission.

This way there are no problems with banned items being tossed over a fence between regions.

Geographical areas allow different regions to be insulated from different regions.

Before anybody thinks the gun free regions would

be the safer ones, lets look at statistics.

Switzerland has a huge number of guns including fully automatic machine guns stored in peoples houses (everybody of a certain age is in their national guard).

Yet Switzerland has a very small crime rate. Other places like Haiti, Washington DC, and others have a much higher crime rate despite a strict ban on guns. Some people give excuses such as guns coming in from nearby places that allow guns, but if that was the reason then why are the freedom places not awash in the same high crime rate?

Another thing to consider is the fact that many wild animals attack and kill or badly injure people. Guns have saved many human lives.

Guns are very good in the hands of responsible people, and if somebody isn't responsible then perhaps they should not be making decisions for those who are responsible.

Another reason to allow guns is to prevent genocides. There have been a lot of examples in history where some corrupt government disarmed its people, then wiped out a lot of them.

The Nazi's didn't go into Switzerland.

Why?

Because it would not have been easy to take out people who were armed.

Think about that before considering gun control.

Everybody should have the basic human right to be safe, and that means being able to choose a region to live in that allows guns for protection from dangerous animals or criminals.

Of course being safe also means being safe from irresponsible and untrustworthy people, refer to the chapter on exclusive regions for more about that.

Rights:

1

Every individual person upon becoming an adult has the right to move out of any region and into any other region.

No reason need be given.

The only exception is for exclusive regions, which have the right to weed out troublemakers or anybody else that may not fit in.

exclusive regions have the final say on who may or may not visit or live there.

However, if you are denied entry to an exclusive region, you may set up your own region with your friends or associates, assuming there are enough of you to make a region, and are responsible enough to manage a region. The full set of requirements for

creating a region will be discussed elsewhere.

Exclusive regions can not deny people the right to leave upon becoming an adult, they only have the right to deny entry to anybody. Basically all humans are equal, thus you can go anyplace on earth except the exclusive regions. Your rights end where other peoples rights begin, thus if exclusive regions don't

want any more people in their region, they have the right to exclude people.

For the purposes of this page, adult is anybody 18 years of age or older. If a region wishes to set a lower age thats fine, but no higher age. Regions cannot trap people by setting unrealistic ages.

The government of a region where somebody is brought up, is obligated to provide transportation out of the region to anybody who requests it, upon that person becoming an adult.

In other words, when a person grows up and decides which region to live in, the home region is required to provide transportation to the desired region.

If the person is not happy in the new region, they might be responsible for their own transportation at that point, this is not free transportation for life, just to get started.

If a huge number of people want to leave a region, then maybe the leaders of that region should change whatever they are doing wrong, and make the region a more attractive place to stay, instead of complaining about the expense of paying transportation out.

2.

Education.

Every person old enough to be able to learn to read, has the right to an education to include history of earth and the regions. This is to ensure that the person can make an informed decision upon becoming an adult, as to which region he or she would like to live in.

every person also has the right to know of these basic human rights.

No region may deny this or any basic right, to anybody, for any reason, including a state of emergency, martial law, or any other problem that may be happening in their region or with earth in general.

Any individual has the right to be informed of current events in other regions, this news to be provided by neutral sources such as the internet, or the alliance, or the region where the events are taking place.

In other words, the region where a person lives does not have exclusive rights to deliver or edit news that may influence a persons decision to leave the region.

To clarify, every individual has the right to independent news sources. News cannot be censored until and unless the person becomes an adult and agrees to the censorship by remaining in a region that has censorship.

All students in school, in any region, have the right to browse the uncensored internet and hear news and

opinions from all other regions. Students need to have a balanced, fair, free source of information so they can make an intelligent informed decision as to what region they want to live in once they become an adult.

People who are already adults by the time this goes into effect, also have the right to a no-censorship period of time where they can see their options and make an informed decision on what region they want to live in.

While all regions are autonomous, they must remember that the reason they exist is to serve the people, thus all regions must allow all children the basic human rights such as to learn about their choices of what region would be best for them to live in.

Censorship is a blight on the face of humanity.

Censorship is only allowed for adults who agree to it.

Regions may present their side of an issue, to counter lies told by other sources, but it is the persons right to hear both sides of the argument.

Every person in every region needs to be able to read or be shown a video of the default region, and the list of human rights pertaining to it, so every person knows the rights they can have if they want them. This is vital to ensure that some regions don't deprive people of freedoms that the people didn't even know they were entitled to.

The video of the default region should be one produced by the default region, not one produced by some other region that is opposed to it. This will ensure the video doesn't become propaganda against

the default region.

The default region is a freedom region where you can do anything you want as long as you are not hurting anybody.

People have rights,  
and all people have the right to know that, and to know that they can have the freedoms in the default region.

It is morally reprehensible to guide people into a life that is anything less than they may want.

Freedom is good, and it is worth fighting for and living for.

Parents do not own their children, thus are unable to deprive them of a worldly education.

Parents may have produced the children, but once the child is old enough to read, the child has these rights and cannot be denied the rights for any reason.

Parents rights have boundaries.

We must put the children first.

3

Every individual owns his or her body exclusively, until becoming an adult and, if desired, moving to a different region.

No region, company, person, or any other entity may ever modify anybody's body without their permission, at least until the person is an adult and has had an opportunity to move to a different region.

As long as even one person wants to live in a region where each individual person owns his/her body, then such a region must be maintained.

An example will be used, however bearing in mind that any modification to the body is forbidden, not just the example used.

If a kid is caught stealing a candy bar, it is illegal to cut the kids hand off.

The kid has a right to grow up to the point of becoming responsible, without being mutilated in any way.

If the kid grows up and then decides to stay in a region that allows mutilation for punishment, then the choice was made by an informed adult, and that is OK.

However if the kid grows up in a region that uses mutilation for punishment, and upon becoming an adult decides to move to a better region, then the home region must allow him or her to leave without being mutilated.

Anybody who is not an adult, is not able to give consent for anything permanent. Thus if a kid agrees to be punished by mutilation, it is still forbidden to mutilate him or her.

This human right is intended to cover anything permanent that would be done before the person becomes an adult.

Thus kids may not be subjected to such things as female genital mutilation, or male castration, lobotomies, electric shock therapy, or any medical procedure that the person refuses, including

medication.

Female genital mutilation is sometimes known as female circumcision although this is not really very accurate.

Electric shock therapy may not seem to cause physical changes, at least nothing visible, yet it does cause changes to the brain, obviously, or it wouldn't be used.

These changes are unacceptable since a persons personality is contained in the brain, and we cannot be certain that the changes would be for the better.

Anybody who violates a victims human rights has committed an atrocity against humanity, and may be punished with capital punishment even if the region they live in does not allow capital punishment.

Capital punishment is not required, however if capital punishment is used then it must be a quick painless death. Capital punishment is highly recommended, not as a deterrent, but to convey the seriousness of basic human rights, and also to ensure that the criminal does not ever repeat the crime.

It would be better to err on the side of caution and execute people violating human rights, even though some innocent people may be executed by mistake, than to risk allowing a guilty person to repeat the crime of violating human rights. Everybody is going to die, but as long as they live their life with rights and dignity, then the most important thing has been accomplished. Naturally we should still put a lot of effort into avoiding any mistakes.

This human right (owning ones body) has one and only

one exception to it. We are talking about male, not female, circumcision.

Circumcision has the effect of reducing the cases of cancer of the penis to essentially zero. While it is true that some doctors can botch the procedure and cause serious problems for the patient, this can be avoided by training more doctors so we have enough doctors so that they are not so overworked, and using other similar methods.

The total overall number of problems is less with circumcision than by not doing it and seeing cancer later.

Some people may claim it takes away some feeling but the vast overwhelming majority

of people don't notice any problem whatsoever, and benefit greatly overall. Circumcision should be done as an infant so he can grow up without cancer and live to have a good life.

Circumcision probably should not be forced as a requirement, but this could be reviewed, in light of the benefits obtained.

It is a balance between the autonomy of regions and the human right to not have cancer. The author suggests that the human right to avoid cancer should be the bigger consideration, but lets not have a war over it.

To avoid problems, new doctors should be supervised by an experienced doctor during the first several circumcisions.

Medication as used here is referring to pharmaceuticals or anything similar imposed against their will.

It does not refer to having a beer. Alcohol is a relatively natural substance like marijuana and is not what we are talking about. Thus it is not a violation of human rights to have a beer or smoke marijuana, as long as it is not forced upon the person. So vaccinating a child against polio is not forbidden by these rights. Common sense must be used in interpreting these rights. If the person consents to it and it doesn't cause any mutilation, then it is probably ok especially if it benefits the person. However if the person does not consent to it, then the alliance should step in and protect the persons right to refuse it.

See the chapter on the pharmaceutical industry for important details.

4.

Children have rights too.

They have the right to safety while growing up so they can be alive to choose a better region to live in.

If a child is unhappy in a region, then he should probably be allowed to move to a better region, even if his parents don't like it.

Parents don't own the child.

### **Final words:**

No person or group including countries or regions, has the power to take away any of these basic human rights, for any reason, even temporarily, even and especially during times of crisis.

Before this was written, various countries and international organizations have done things like declare martial law and suspended rights and freedoms.

That was wrong and will not be tolerated ever again, within the context of the basic human rights listed above.

**This is vital:**

We must let nothing interfere with these basic human rights. There are a lot of different cultures in the world, and that is fine, but all children deserve to be able to have a worldly education to prepare them for a long and rewarding life.

This means that parents must not be allowed to deprive their kids of a decent education.

Parents rights are one thing, but the kids have rights too. The parents are adults and have had their chance to make their decisions, but kids are learning and should have the chance to have a good life. Parents should not be allowed to attempt to limit their children based on some primitive superstitions or cultures.

A younger age is fine for things like deciding to move to a better region, but not for giving up their rights.

It is patently wrong to trick a youngster into giving up his rights at a young age, thus we make it illegal to lose your rights before the age of 18 years.

Freedom should always come first.

Important:

Do not try to impose any agenda on the world by

calling it a right and inserting it here.  
Everybodys personal agenda is best fitted to one  
individual region of like minded people.  
If you attempt to insert unpopular agenda here,  
nobody will agree to it.

## **Chapter 12:**

### **Citizenship**

All humans are citizens of the human race,  
not citizens of a region.

People reside in a region, but are citizens of earth.

This is an important distinction between countries and regions. All humans are equal as to having human rights and a fair share of the planet and its resources.

It is important to be citizens of earth instead of citizens of a region, because this helps all people understand that we are part of the same team.

Lets face it, where a person was born is really irrelevant, he is still as much a human being as anybody else, and should still have human rights.

All humans regardless of sex, sexual orientation, race, religion, national origin, or any other consideration, are still humans and are still citizens of earth.

In the future, when space travel becomes common, and somebody is born in space, they are still considered a citizen of earth, and ideally should still have the right to live on earth, not be stuck on some space station.

Being a human is all that is required for earth citizenship.

## **Chapter 13:**

### **Health.**

Disclaimer:

this is not medical advice.

If you have a medical problem, see a doctor.

Each individual person has their own metabolism and needs.

This article has tips of a general nature,  
that you should discuss

with your doctor before implementing.

Always follow your doctors advice because your doctor  
knows your specific needs.

Be sure to see a doctor at regular intervals.

#### **Hidden health hazards:**

These days, practically all baked and fast  
foods have hydrogenated oils, sometimes called trans  
fats.

Even quality restaurants often use them.

A number of respected studies indicate that foods  
containing hydrogenated oils are contributing to  
heart attacks. These foods may even be worse than  
saturated fats.

It is possible that these foods have contributed to  
the epidemic of heart attacks of recent decades.

Harvard published a report indicating they suspect as  
many as 100,000 people die prematurely every year  
because of hydrogenated oils.

This is a danger that can sometimes strike people while they are relatively young.

Sometimes people in their twenties have even had heart attacks so this is not a good thing to ignore.

The food label does not always give clear warning. Sometimes the label says no trans fats, but it still has hydrogenated oil in it, so be careful.

The law should be changed regarding this labeling requirement.

Currently they are able to round off numbers and put zero on the label even though it is not zero.

Some companies actually claim their food is healthy for you, despite a lot of evidence from respected medical studies indicating otherwise.

don't believe everything you see on those food packages or advertisements.

Manufacturers love these hydrogenated oils because they are cheap, it saves them money.

Some fast foods don't even have a nutritional label. If you cant tell the ingredients, you should assume it is bad for you.

At least one country has already banned these oils from food.

The reason we need to change the laws is that people don't always have the time to read labels to reject unhealthy food, plus when most manufacturers are making the bad food it becomes very challenging to find something good.

The larger lesson here is that industry does things

to maximize their profits, and thousands of people die an early death because of it. We need to change the system so the people come first, and profits second.

Not just for hydrogenated oils, but for all future things the industries will do to us.

Industries do all kinds of tricks such as using an unrealistically small serving size, knowing people will eat 3 or more servings at a time. Since the serving size is small, the amount of oils is lower per serving and this makes it look good on the label, especially when they are able to round it off to zero. But people eat a more realistic amount of food and get more oils than you would think by looking at the label.

Some fatty acids are required by the body. Omega 3 and 6 are considered necessary for the body in the proper quantities.

The important thing to remember is that money, profits, are what prompts the industry to use these possibly harmful hydrogenated oils in our food. If we come up with a system that negates the profit motive, then we can benefit from better health. Money really is the root of all evil.

### **Kidney stones:**

Especially if you are male, drink enough water and avoid having excessive amounts of milk, to reduce the chance of getting painful kidney stones. don't drink excessive amounts of plain water all at once though, it can cause an electrolyte imbalance that can cause fatal cardiac arrest.

2 liters (half a gallon) of water spread out over the

whole day should be good for health.  
Have more if needed such as very hot days.

### **Sleep:**

Getting a bit extra sleep has been shown to result in a higher score on IQ tests.

Working at maximum potential helps prevent mistakes which can prevent unnecessary suffering both for you and others you may affect.

Enough sleep also helps immune system function.

### **Tired doctors:**

The existing establishment forces many medical professionals to work long hours and go without enough sleep.

Studies have shown that medical interns who have to work long hours and get less sleep, make more serious errors than interns who had a traditional schedule and more sleep.

The errors were similar to those you would expect to see with alcohol intoxication.

To clarify, doctors are not drinking, but the serious errors are the type you would expect from drinking.

We should all insist that our doctors be allowed to have enough time for sleep.

If there are not enough doctors, then lets train some more of them so there is enough coverage and everybody can get enough rest.

Many people die or suffer serious long lasting problems from medical errors. This could affect you or anybody.

The existing establishment will likely show little interest in making things better.

But when we switch to regions, we can insist that the regions do things better.

Note that these problems are not the doctors fault, it is the bureaucrats fault for not making laws limiting the hours doctors can work, which results in an

insufficient number of people being trained to become doctors, resulting in a shortage of doctors.

The bureaucrats could fix these problems if they wanted to, its just a question of do they want to.

The existing system is obviously failing the people.

### **Super foods:**

Early results appear to show that eating the super foods can help a person live about 7 years longer than normal.

The best thing though is that the extra years are more enjoyable because of better health and fewer health problems.

The super foods are fish, fruits/vegetables, dark chocolate, garlic, almonds, and wine.

It is not necessary to have all of these.

A lot of benefit can be had by having some or most of

the foods. In particular, you may want to skip the wine since it is so easy to overdo alcohol and cause more problems than you solve.

### **Making exercise more fun:**

When you are young and/or healthy, you tend to think it will stay this way forever, or maybe it wont but theres not much you can do about it.

But there is a huge amount you can do and its not really that hard.

Failing to take good care of your health is usually not noticeable for a while because its a gradual decline, but it does catch up with you.

By then its sometimes too late, and even if not, you wont be as well off.

It cannot be overstated how important exercise is. And it does not need to be boring, it can be a lot of fun especially if you listen to fast paced music while doing it.

Exercising to music or even in front of the TV helps a lot. Exercising with a friend makes it even better.

Some people get bored with a routine, and will benefit from a variety of different exercises.

### **Cancer:**

Selenium is a mineral essential for health.

It is rare for somebody to be so low on it that they get sick right away.

However most people don't get enough for optimal health.

Medical studies have shown a 39% reduction in the incidence of cancer, among people who take a supplement of 200 mcg of selenium.

If you don't know much about cancer, it can be a very painful way to die early. Cancer kills people even during childhood sometimes, and early in adult life too. You could get cancer anytime.

Be careful taking selenium though, since too much is toxic.

One of the responsibilities of the alliance should be to gather all health tips and put them in one place in an organized and easy to read format, and translate it into all languages.

Then it should be included in education given to all children all over earth.

It should also be posted on the alliances web site for adults.

This will prevent many health problems and greatly help to eliminate the unnecessary suffering that has infested this planet for far too long now.

## **Chapter 14:**

### **Marijuana.**

#### **Brain cancer:**

The most common brain cancer, Glioblastoma multiforme, is extremely difficult to treat with conventional methods.

Radiotherapy, chemotherapy and surgery are frequently not effective.

Medical researchers in Spain have discovered that one of the components in marijuana tends to increase the activity of ceramide, which could lead to a cure for brain cancer, and possibly other cancer cures.

The pharmaceutical industry doesn't like marijuana because it is a naturally occurring plant that cannot be patented and allow the industry to overcharge for it.

As usual, money is the root of all evil, and results in a great deal of unnecessary human suffering as the pharmaceutical industry uses its money to make phony public service ads to discourage marijuana and keep it illegal, so the pharmaceutical industry can sell patented medicines that don't work as well.

The end result:

people suffer and die while the pharmaceutical

industry gets richer.

And you or somebody you care about will be the next to get sick and die while they get rich and laugh at you some more.

### **Medical marijuana:**

The war on drugs has gone so far as to tell doctors what they can and cannot prescribe to patients.

Who has gone to medical school for many years?

The bureaucrats?

No.

Wouldn't you rather have your doctor make your medical decisions, instead of some crusty bureaucrat?

Who do you trust more, your doctor, or your bureaucrat?

Maybe it doesn't matter to you right now, but if somebody you care about should ever get cancer or some other painful medical condition, you would like something effective to reduce the pain.

Pharmaceuticals are not as effective at reducing the pain. Pharmaceuticals also don't keep you alert enough to continue doing the things you like to do.

Medical marijuana has the advantage that it is not even addictive, unlike morphine.

Pharmaceutical companies don't like marijuana because

as a naturally occurring substance it cannot be patented, and allow them to overcharge for it.

## **History:**

While thousands of people die every year from alcohol overdoses, such as passing out and choking to death on their own vomit, nobody has ever died from such a problem with marijuana.

Marijuana has been used for thousands of years, legally. It was only recently prohibited, which of course doesn't mean its not available anymore.

Since then many lies have been told about it, but this book tells the truth and these facts can be verified by anybody who doubts it.

One common misconception is that only troublemakers use drugs. In reality, many professionals like doctors, lawyers, computer programmers, artists, and many other good people use drugs but don't want to tell anybody about it because drugs are illegal.

Professionals have a lot to lose.

Many employers will fire somebody for using drugs, if they find out about it. Therefore the professionals don't tell anybody about their drug use.

Troublemakers don't have much to lose, thus don't care, so it is easy to see them using or talking about drugs. This gives people the false impression that only bad people use drugs. In reality, millions of good people use marijuana right now, and don't

cause any problems.

### **Prescription painkillers:**

Certain companies in the pharmaceutical industry stand to lose money if people used marijuana or other naturally occurring plants as a painkiller.

Natural plants cannot be patented. The companies would prefer people use their prescription medications instead, because those can be patented and allow the company to overcharge for them and make an obscene profit.

If you don't care about the higher cost, what about the liver and kidney toxicity of the prescriptions? Many prescription painkillers have deleterious affects on the kidneys which results in your having to go on dialysis sooner than you might like.

These prescriptions cause a lot of pain and suffering, as well as extra expenses. All so the industry can make extra money at the expense of your health. Don't believe it? Research it for yourself.

Even over the counter painkillers often have toxic affects. It doesn't hit you immediately but time passes quickly and before you know it, you may have health problems.

Many people have used natural plants for decades and show no signs of liver or kidney problems. The medical evidence cannot be denied.

A recent study suggests acetaminophen, a common over the counter (nonprescription) painkiller, may account

for 10% of all cases of renal disease.

Marijuana has never caused an overdose or any kidney failure.

If you had done the research for this book, you would be incensed by what you learned about how the pharmaceutical industry has ruined the health of so many people, just to make a little extra money for the industry that is already filthy rich. It is a crime against humanity.

Of course what is most disturbing is the fact that many people don't seem to care.

Perhaps some people deserve the mistreatment that they are getting, but that still doesn't excuse the mistreatment of the rest of us.

### **Brains:**

In the old days, it was thought that the brain never grew new cells, but this was disproved a while ago.

New nerve cells are always being produced in a part of the brain known as the hippocampus, which is important in learning and memory.

This is important because old cells die, and need to be replaced with new cells, to prevent or reduce brain deterioration.

Legal substances like alcohol and nicotine have been proven to suppress the new brain cell growth.

A synthetic version of THC, the main component in marijuana, has been recently proven to stimulate new

brain cell growth in the hippocampus.

This means that marijuana is better than alcohol or nicotine.

It should be noted that some countries are already allowing its use, and they often have lower crime rates than places that ban it.

Don't allow yourself to be tricked by any bureaucrats who put out false information. Bureaucrats are often bribed by companies that stand to lose money if marijuana is legalized.

Many companies stand to lose money if people switch to marijuana. Those companies are often caught funding public service ads which state false or misleading information. Research this for yourself.

### **Civil disobedience:**

It is wrong to obey or enforce many of the laws that restrict freedom. When Rosa Parks refused to give up her bus seat to a white man, her act led to changes in what we jokingly call society.

Those laws regarding bus seats are no longer on the books, but other laws are still restricting other types of freedoms.

It is just as wrong to deprive anybody of any

freedom regardless of how you personally feel about it.

Freedom means allowing other people to have freedom too, not just the freedoms you personally would like to have. If you don't give others freedom, then they won't give you freedom, and everybody loses. You are required to respect all freedom for all people.

For example, the laws against marijuana are causing a lot of problems because people will often use a more harmful substitute to avoid running afoul of the injustice system.

This leads to people using alcohol, which has harmed and killed many people. This does not mean we should bring back the prohibition of alcohol, because that would be wrong even if you were able to enforce it, which of course you can't.

The point is that nobody has ever overdosed on marijuana, but many people have died from alcohol after passing out and choking to death on their own vomit.

Alcohol has also led to violence and other problems that are not seen with marijuana.

This does not mean to talk everybody out of drinking, since many people are not having any

problem with drinking.

What it does mean is that it is wrong to have nonsensical laws that make the most harmful substances legal and then ban the virtually harmless ones.

It is wrong to obey or enforce those types of laws. Perhaps we need some sort of civil disobedience just like Rosa Parks, to lead to the reform of these harmful laws.

Any law that harms freedom, harms all of us even if it doesn't lead to the substitution of more harmful recreational substances like alcohol.

It should be noted that alcohol is not the only substitute that people use.

Inhalants and other very harmful things are also killing people because of those brain dead laws.

If you are not yet aware of the inhalant problem, then you should research it, especially if you are a parent, because your child's safety is at serious risk due to those laws.

Inhalants are common substances like paint, glue, even air fresheners, that are inhaled to cause some sort of a high feeling. It is extremely hazardous to people's health and can cause death.

Inhalants are poisons, not drugs, but are used when safer substances are banned by the incompetent government.

Note that all such websites are pressured into suppressing certain information for fear of being sued, thus they will not advocate substituting a safe but illegal substance like marijuana, until the laws are reformed, restoring marijuana to its original legal status.

The education system needs to be reformed to ensure everybody on earth is educated as to these problems. This act alone would go a long way towards ending world suffering.

## **Chapter 15:**

### **Miscellaneous thoughts.**

#### **Neural plasticity:**

The simple description of neural plasticity is described as you cant teach an old dog new tricks.

This of course refers to people not dogs.

When people grow up, many of them lose the ability to easily learn new things.

There is a lot of material already written about this subject if you need more details.

The point is that it is vitally important to educate kids early about the importance of freedom.

Many people grow up without realizing the importance of freedom, and then it is too late for them to learn, because of neural plasticity issues. This is bad because freedom is good, it is vitally important.

We must stress the importance of freedom because freedom is essential to leading a good life full of fun. It is hard to have a lot of fun when you are without freedom, submitting to the tyranny of the horrible people who don't appreciate freedom.

Beware of some places that claim to have freedom but don't really have much freedom at all. They might have more freedom than average but thats only because the average is so low at this point in time.

Some regions, and some existing countries, may have some degree of freedom, but the whole world will not be rid of suffering until everybody has the option of freedom.

If an adult declines freedom then that is fine, but they need the ability to decide for themselves.

### **Education:**

Everybody love videos these days.

If schools and colleges used video lessons more, instead of having an instructor stand there and talk, the kids would likely pay more attention and learn more.

By videos, we mean DVD's or computer lessons.

Another improvement is self paced computer lessons where a lesson is read as text possibly with pictures or videos, depending on the subject.

These allow each student to proceed at his own pace on his individual computer. Tests are also given by computer and automatically scored by the computer.

This allows students to work up to their maximum potential instead of being held back by the slower students in class.

This can be done at home or in a classroom.

This is not a new concept but is not being used enough.

It also allows slower students to take enough time to learn, instead of having problems keeping up.

Teachers should not fear this new technology.

Teachers will still be needed to supervise, and answer questions when somebody doesn't understand, and all kinds of other things.

Another change that should be made is to reduce emphasis on the exact date that some event occurred in history.

It is far more important to remember the reasons that a war took place, instead of memorizing the date that it occurred.

Too much time is wasted in history classes on memorizing useless information, making the class more boring and taking away interest in everything else.

All children everywhere on earth, forever, have the right and obligation to listen to material prepared by the alliance which explains their basic human rights, and conditions in all the other regions.

No region can deny children the ability to listen to this material.

This material is not extensive, it is merely part of the kids education.

This is to prevent any incompetent regions from preventing their children from having a worldly education.

All regions are required to teach all their children the material prepared by the alliance for these few

classes so the children will be able to make an informed decision upon growing up, as to which region they want to live in.

It is understandable that parents may not want to have an outside party educating their kids, but it is irresponsible to assume all parents will be able to provide a worldly decent education.

The solution to this problem is to let parents teach some material, and the alliance teach some material. This way the kids get a variety of educational material and can make up their own minds by being well informed.

No excuses will be tolerated, ever, for denying children a worldly education, especially including religious reasons.

This book should be required reading in all schools on earth.

The book can be translated but it needs to be done in its entirety, no sections can be left out.

### **Lawsuits:**

Some countries already are seeing a disturbing trend where practically everybody is suing everybody for anything and everything.

This is stifling free speech because some people are starting to become afraid to post

anything on the internet for fear of being sued for it.

Lawsuits are very expensive for the person getting sued, lawyers always overcharge in the countries where this is starting.

Like many problems, this one will likely come to your area if you don't act now to stop it, by joining the alliance described in this book.

Some people advocate the system be changed so if a person wants to sue somebody, the person losing the lawsuit should pay all the legal costs of the winner. But this still isn't good enough since some innocent people may lose the lawsuit because no system is perfect.

The best solution is to let people post anything they want.

The people being talked about will have to get over it, or could perhaps post their side of the story. This should be the system in the default regions.

This is good because it encourages people to say whats going on without fear of being sued. Information gets out there in the public eye, and assuming most of it is true, then it benefits the public.

People deserve to be able to know whats going on. Freedom should always come first.

As for other types of lawsuits,

binding arbitration should be used instead of lawsuits, because they are cheaper, and frequently are done by private companies which are much more efficient than a government monopoly.

### **Federalism:**

People are different, and will never agree on one set of rules. This is part of the reason why the federal system of government is unacceptable on a global scale.

It is good to have basic human rights that apply everywhere, but laws that take away the freedom to do something are unacceptable when imposed on people against their will.

The federal system makes federal laws that are imposed on all people regardless of where they are.

Federal laws apply everywhere, even where people oppose them. This is fundamentally flawed. The federal system is the polar opposite of freedom.

One example of how the federal system is inherently flawed is the federal law in the United States that made it illegal to help an escaped slave.

This is a perfect example of how the majority may approve an amendment or law, but that doesn't make it right.

Since the federal system imposes its unwanted, unnecessary, harmful laws on all its subjects, there is no place to go to get away from it within the country.

Imagine that on a global scale.

What a nightmare. We must do everything in our power to prevent this atrocity from developing.

Technically it is already developing on a global scale with United Nations treaties, and extradition. Some countries even extradite people who have never been to that country and are not citizens, for a variety of reasons that are little better than excuses.

Some of these countries even go so far as to kidnap the suspects and bring them into the countries jurisdiction, when they are not able to legally extradite them.

We need regional control, so if one or more regions does something stupid, the good and intelligent people can move to better regions and avoid the problems.

We also need an alliance that ensures that all people have the right to move to regions of their choice. This ensures the rights of people in all regions, while preserving the independence of all regions.

Naturally the alliance needs to prevent rogue regions from extraditing people who have never even been to

the rogue region.

### **The war on freedom:**

Some companies are starting to fire people for cigarettes even if they only smoke at home.

They have to take a test for nicotine, and refusal to take the test gets them fired, just as coming up positive on the test.

They also refuse to hire people who don't agree to the test.

One excuse companies give is that smokers have higher medical insurance costs.

Its true smoking cigarettes isn't the greatest thing, but whats next?

There are all kinds of activities with potential health hazards, will those be banned too?

What about skiing, obesity, having a motorcycle, or perhaps something you care about?

Will they refuse to hire democrats next?

Before you think this is too far fetched, lets remember that compared to republicans, democrats as a group are less affluent and more likely to be divorced or separated, more likely to smoke, or be suicidal.

So as a group, democrats are costing the employer more money just like the smokers, so don't be too surprised if they start refusing to hire democrats next.

You know that if the firings for smoking are allowed to stand, they will start banning all kinds of other activities.

That's how the injustice system works, it sets a precedent then uses that precedent to accomplish its goals which undermine freedom.

Freedoms are declining all around the world. If this is allowed to continue as it has, there will soon be no place to go that has any freedom left.

Freedom will become a forgotten concept.
