

IDEAS FOR MEMBER MISSIONARIES

KEEP YOURSELF PREPARED

1. Constantly and sincerely ask the Lord for a missionary experience.
2. Have a Family Home Evening to make a missionary work plan.
3. Study missionaries in the scriptures and apply what you learn in your life.
4. Always be thinking "How can I share the gospel with this person?" even if you think it's unlikely they'd accept it.

BUILD ZION

5. Go on companionship exchanges (splits) with the missionaries.
6. Home and visiting teaching -- do it...Over-do it!
7. Get to know all the members of the ward, active and less active.
8. Take responsibility for making sure visitors at church feel very, very welcome (if you don't know if there are any, ask the missionaries).
9. Befriend new converts and invite them to do things with your family.

PREPARE PEOPLE FOR THE MESSAGE

10. Hang LDS pictures in your office. (Temples, family proclamation, etc.)
11. Display a Book of Mormon prominently in your home or office.
12. Keep a Book of Mormon in your vehicle and in your home and be ready to give them away at any opportunity.
13. Give Book of Mormon copies with your testimony in it to friends, family and co-workers.
14. Follow-up with people you've given a Book of Mormon to ("What did you think? What questions do you have?...").
15. Invite neighbors and co-workers to dinner.
16. Use your own imagination and talents. There's a million ways to prepare people for the gospel message. But the most important is:
17. Make friends with your neighbors and other non-members - be involved in their lives.

INVITE!

The Lord commands: "Open your mouth"! Overcome fear and INVITE people to:

18. Family Home Evening
19. a church/scout/Young Women's activity.
20. Sunday worship services
21. Invite non-members to your home to meet with the missionaries in your home.

22. Do It
