Subject: Actual and Constructive Administrative Notice

Honorable Mr. President:

I, Edwin F. Smith-Ka-Nam, Head Chief of the Snoqualmoo Tribe, deliver this Actual and Constructive Administrative Notice to you, William J. Clinton, President of the Republic, United States of America. The Snoqualmoo Tribe is a treaty partner with the republic United States of America under the 1855 Point Elliott Treaty. The Point Elliot Treaty was ratified by your congress on 8 March, 1859, and confirmed by President Buchanan on 11 April, 1859.

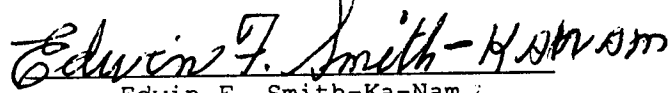
In order for the Snoqualmoo Tribe to fulfill its duties under the treaty we require the following:

1. Acknowledgment, by presidential proclamation or letter, that the Snoqualmoo Tribe is party, along with the republic United States of America, to the 1855 Point Elliott Treaty;
2. Presidential recognition that the authority of the Snoqualmoo Tribe to control, license and regulate all hunting, fishing and gathering rights conferred by the Treaty to its tribal members is unqualified; provided that such regulatory authority shall be exercised in conformance to the laws of the republic United States of America.

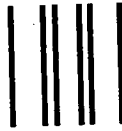
Notice is hereby given that the Snoqualmoo Tribe is acting in "good faith" in asserting its rights under The Point Elliot Treaty. Receipt of this Actual and Constructive Notice evidences the Snoqualmoo Tribe's authority to regulate all hunting, fishing and gathering rights conferred thereby.

You are also hereby noticed that all communications between the republic United States of America and the Sovereign Snoqualmoo Tribe shall be conducted between a duly authorized presidential representative and the Head Chief of the Snoqualmoo Tribe.

Thank you for your prompt attention to these important matters.
