NOTICE OF TRIBAL SOCIETY

FOR PUBLIC RELEASE

TO: Office of the Secretary of State, The State of Washington

In keeping with the cultural creed of the Snoqualmoo people, indigenous people of the Pacific Northwest, and in harmony with the Constitution for the united States of America, the original covenant between “We the People,” Sovereign inhabitants upon the land of the North American continent, did not, have not and will not yield our sovereignty to those agencies which “We the People” created or contracted with to, among other things, “regulate commerce with foreign nations, and among the several states , and with the Indian tribes.” To the extent that an aggregate corporation is an artificial creation of the State, it is declared by the First Article of the Bill of Rights for that constitution (as was the intent of the framers) that “Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion , or prohibiting the free exercise thereof;...or the right of the people to peaceably assemble” by the creation of incorporated State church or Indian tribal society. The below named Assembly (Indian tribe), a Sovereign Family un-incorporated tribal (religious) society, recognizes no authority from State for its existence, but derives its authority of existence only from the Great Spirit who created our ancestors. And no other. However, as courtesy, and to eternally identify the name and identity of this tribe, acknowledged by the Congress of the United States by the ratified 1855 Point Elliot Treaty, the undersigned does hereby present this NOTICE:

1. The name of this tribe is: Snoqualmoo Tribe
2. The term of existence is: PERPETUAL
3. The purposes for which this tribe is organized is as follows: To insure the tribes compliance with its duties under the 1855 Point Elliot Treaty and administer the rights, privileges and immunities retained by the tribe in the ratified 1855 Point Eliot Treaty in

conformance to the Constitution of the Snoqualmoo Tribe as it is or may be amended hereinafter.

And, as Agent for this Sovereign Tribal unincorporated Indian Tribe, consent to receive service of process, at the address set forth below, forward all mail and, but only as a courtesy, to notify the office of the Secretary of State for The State of Washington, in the event of abdication or any change in the address of the Office of the Head Chief.

Discipline I

Founding

The Allied Snoqualmoo Tribes are, have and continue to be a familial association of individuals whose presence, within the political boundaries of The State of Washington, United States of America upon the continent of North America, predates both the settlement by, and even the arrival of, people descended and immigrated from other parts of the world. The Chiefs of the Allied Snoqualmoo Indian Tribes knowingly entered into the 1855 Point Elliott Treaty with the intent to do those things which will preserve, promote and insure the tribes continuing Sovereign existence and compliance with its contractual duties under the 1855 Point Elliot Treaty. The head Chief administers the rights, privileges and immunities retained by the tribe in the ratified 1855 Point Eliot Treaty in conformance to the Constitution of the Snoqualmoo Tribe as it is, or may ever be amended, and seeks to advance the wisdom, culture and heritage of the Allied Snoqualmoo treaty signers of the 1855 Point Elliot Treaty to their posterity. This written instrument is for the purpose of identification, recognition and acknowledgement of this Sovereign entity.

Discipline II

INSTRUMENT OF RECOGNITION

The name of this Sovereign Indian Tribe is:

Snoqualmoo Tribe, a Sovereign un-incorporated tribal society.

Discipline III

PURPOSES

The purpose of this corporation sole is to:

- ☞ Assemble as often as it pleases, or deems necessary, to promote the mutual good, advance the cultural values, further the instruction and edification;
- ☞ Promote true liberty as exemplified by the wise actions of the tribal chiefs and elders who signed the ratified 1855 Point Elliot Treaty;
- ☞ Administer the Snoqualmoo tribe's obligations under the 1855 Point Elliot Treaty with the United States of America;
- ☞ Advance the wisdom, culture and heritage of the Allied Snoqualmoo treaty signers to their posterity;
- ☞ Educate the tribes members as to their natural, valuable and certain Unalienable Rights, endowed and secured by the Supreme Creator of the Universe to the people of the tribe;
- ☞ Do those things which will preserve, promote and insure the tribes compliance with its duties under the 1855 Point Elliot Treaty, administer the rights, privileges and immunities retained by the tribe in the ratified 1855 Point Eliot Treaty in conformance to the Constitution of the Snoqualmoo Tribe as it is or may be amended hereinafter;
- ☞ Expand the awareness of the people of the values, wisdom and character of their ancestors.

This written instrument is for the purpose of identification, recognition and acknowledgement of this Sovereign entity.

Discipline IV

AUTHORITY

The Head Chief of the Allied Snoqualmoo Nations, a Sovereign un-incorporated tribal society, shall, for the purpose of this instrument, have power to contract in the same manner and to the same extent as a natural man or woman, and may be sued, and may defend in all courts and places, in all matters and proceedings whatsoever. It has authority to borrow money, give promissory notes therefore, to deal in every way in prime notes, noble metals, planchets, stamps, rare earths, mortgages, all manner of edge banking and to secure the payment of same by mortgage or other liens upon property, real and personal. It has authority to buy, sell, lease, mortgage and in every way deal in real and personal property in the same manner as a natural person. It shall have power to appoint counsel, licensed or unlicensed, but any professional or non-professional accounting, legal or other counsel so appointed or employed shall be utilized in a capacity never greater than subordinate co-counsel in any and all litigious matters whether local, national, or international, in order to protect and maintain the right of the tribal society to address all tribunals, courts, hearings, meetings, assemblies and the like, as the superior co-counsel.

All property held in official capacity by the Head Chief over/for the Allied Snoqualmoo Indian Tribes, shall be held in trust for the use, purpose, benefit and behoof of this Sovereign Familial un-incorporated Tribal Society.

Discipline V

VACANCY AND SUCCESSION

The manner in which any vacancy occurring in the Office of the Head Chief over/for the Allied Snoqualmoo Indian Nations, is effected through an appointment according to the following declination: Right of Birth, Family appointment, Non-family appointment.

All non-family appointments must be formally approved by the direct descendants of Chiefs Pat and John Kanim , in order for a non-family member to be appointed successor, and, preferably with the support and blessings of Tribal Council and the general membership of the Snoqualmoo Tribe.
