

Occasion for this article is the fact that according to data from empirical sociological researches, carried out in 1999, 2001 and 2002 year, two times more women than men applied in the Sofia University. The distribution by sex is considered in connection with the subject, applied for, and with the answers to the question "Except in SU "St. Kliment Ohridski", do you intend to apply in another university?". As a result of this three hypotheses are formulated about the candidate-students' intentions of women and men:

- two times more women than men applied;
- for the humanities applied twice more people than for the natural and mathematical subjects;
- for the humanities applied three times more women than men and for the natural and mathematical subjects women and men applied equally.

For testing these hypotheses and finding out the reasons for the observed differences it is necessary to carry out a national representative research of both candidate students and young people who generally do not intend to apply.
