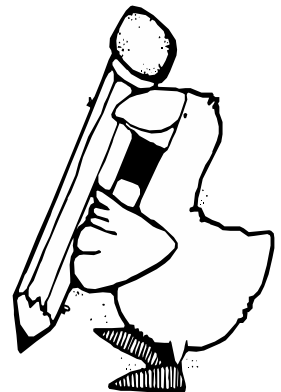


WRITING SEMINAR
