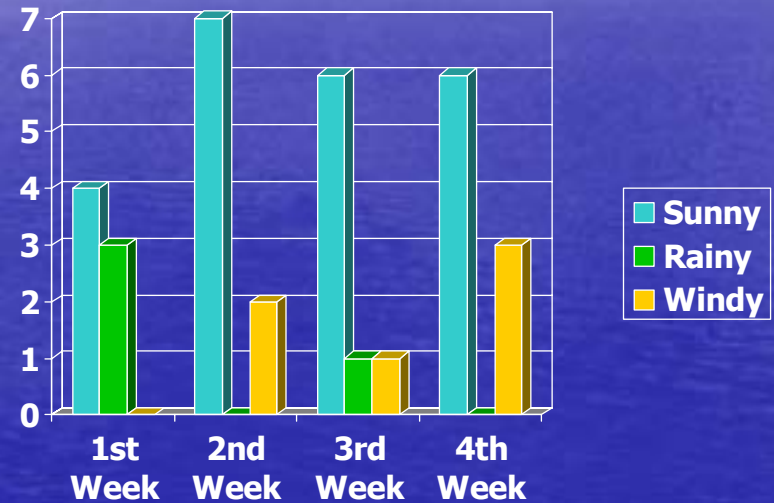

# Adding and Subtracting with the days of Weather:

- Keep totals on a simple graph for each different kinds of weather.
- Create add or subtract stories.



We had  $3 + 1 = 4$  Total Rainy Days

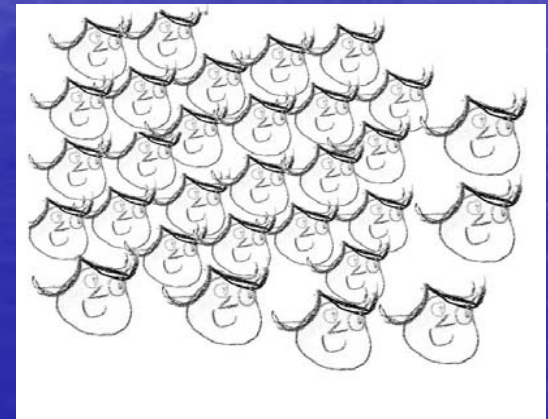
$4 + 7 = 11$  Sunny Days in Weeks 1,2

$11 + 6 = 17$  Sunny Day in Weeks 1-3
