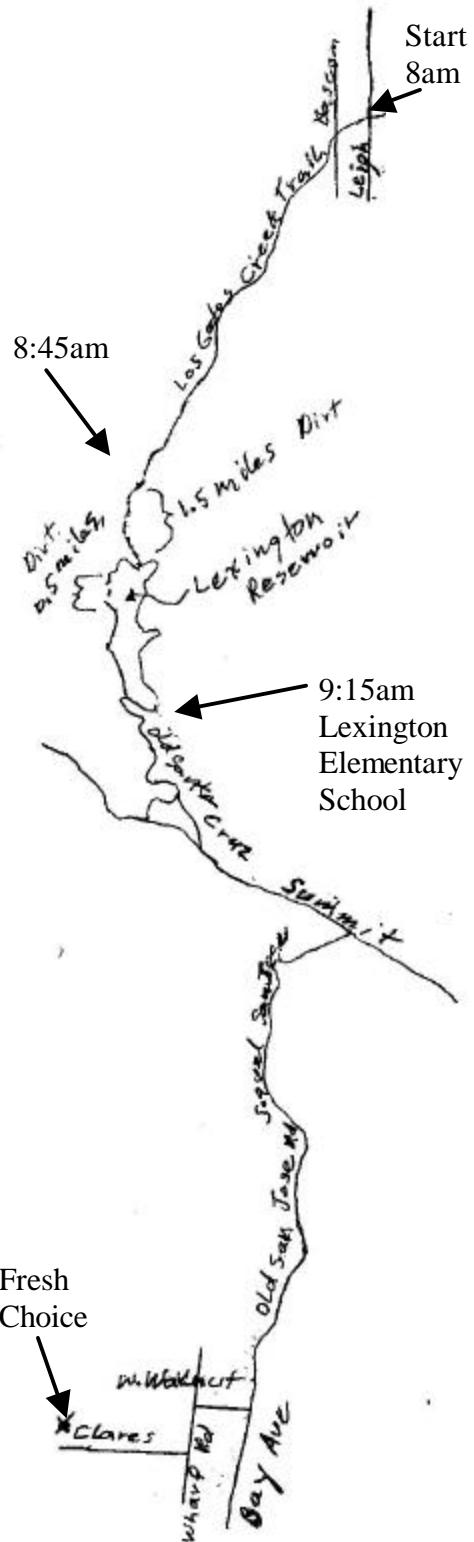
There are several places to join the ride along the path. Here is a list of times and locations:

8:00am Los Gatos Creek Trail and Leigh Avenue (parking at Blackford Elementary School, 1970 Willow St., San Jose)

8:45am at trail under Main Street, Los Gatos (the start of the dirt)

9:15am Lexington Elementary School, 1970 Santa Cruz Highway (parking available for those not wanting to ride the dirt)

4pm back in Los Gatos after 40+ miles
