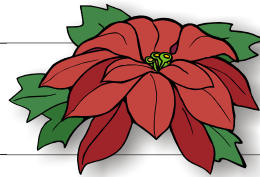
# Season's Greetings

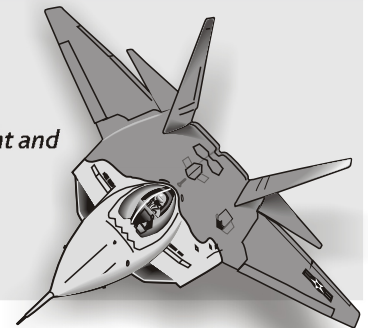
