

# GAP-tastic cowl

## pattern notes

This season, I couldn't help but notice a really cool, huge loopy cowl at the Gap. I may (or may have not) gone in and counted the stitches in this cowl so I could reproduce it accurately. Your home-made GAP-tastic will be even better than the one in the store because you knit it in the round so it's seamless. (Theirs has a seam!) ;)

## materials

- 2 skeins bulky weight yarn (approx. 153 yds each)  
(suggested yarn: Lion Brand Wool-Ease Chunky in Silver Gray)
- US 13 (9 mm) 24" circular needle
- tapestry needle

## directions

Using size US 13 (9 mm) circular needle and long-tail method, CO 131 sts.

Join in the round and place marker.

Row one: \*k1, p1. Repeat from \* across row.

Row two: \*p1, k1. Repeat from \* across row.

Work in seed stitch for 15 inches.

BO in pattern and weave in ends.
