MORNING SESSION: 9:00 AM - NOON

VISITOR CENTER: Knitting the Continental Way with Kristin Rose
 Learn to knit with this "wrist-friendly" technique. Both new and experienced knitters will benefit from exploring this method. With a ball of worsted weight wool and appropriate needles begin a sample scarf.
 Experience level: all Materials: bring worsted wool and needles Fee: \$32

GIFT SHOP: Handspinning on a Drop Spindle with Katie Reimers
 Learn the basics of spinning using hand-carded wool from the Knox Farm flock and a simple top-whorl spindle. You will learn to draft, spin and ply using the Andean technique.
 Experience level: beginner; age 9 & up Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$30

SHEEP BARN: Handpainting Yarn with Food Coloring with Melissa Gardner
 Learn a safe and easy way to create designer handpainted yarn in your own kitchen using food coloring, vinegar and water.
 Experience level: age 9 & up Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$40

HEIFER BARN: Needle-Felted Kitty Kat with Mary Ellen D'Hurizio
 Learn the ins and outs of needle-felting and take home your three-dimensional 4 1/2" kitten made from wool roving. A demonstration of armature-making will be featured.
 Experience level: adult Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$35

AFTERNOON SESSION: 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM

VISITOR CENTER: All Dolled Up with Jackie Hooper
 Dress a 15" hand-sewn muslin doll body with embellishments and embroidery. Learn techniques for faces, clothing, hair and accessories. We'll take photos of you and your "new friend", then have a tea party with the class.
 Experience level: teen and adult Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$45

GIFT SHOP: Freeform Knit and Crochet with Bonnie Morrissey
 Starting with one small shape, learn to 'build' a freeform fabric that will become a bag, fingerless mitten or even the basis for sweater embellishment. We will explore bullion stitch, surface crochet and edgings. Bring an open mind and creative spirit!
 Experience level: Basic knit or crochet stitches. Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$30

SHEEP BARN: Dyeing to Dye Over with Nancy Tepas and Mary Jo LaClair
 This class could easily be called "A Tale of Easy Dyeing." Learn dye methods for that handpainted look in cotton yarn, fabric or paper. A perfect dye class for those who knit, weave, quilt or make scrap books. Everyone takes home a paper they dyed plus yarn samples. Please wear old clothes!
 Experience level: Teen and adult Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$35

HEIFER BARN: Stenciling on Fabric with Brenda Malloy
 Learn to make stencils out of various materials and apply them to fabric with paints. This will be a hands-on playful experience - get ready!
 Experience level: Adult Materials: provided and included in fee Fee: \$33
