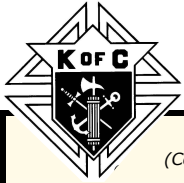

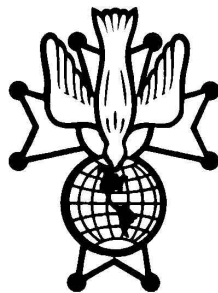
Program Guidelines

3. Applicant can be planning to attend any Catholic High School. If student is already in Catholic High School and needs assistance with new uniforms or school supplies, he/she may apply with a letter stating their circumstances.
