I hope everyone is having a good winter. It seems to be flying by; it'll be spring before we know it!

The Year-End Awards Banquet and Meeting will be February 22nd at Tailgater's in Vining (Clifton). Tailgater's is the former Marty's Club and is located on the west side of Clifton (in Vining). If you are coming into Clifton from the west on Highway 9, turn right at the stop sign beside the school. Tailgater's is about 5 blocks west at the corner of Bridge and Parallel streets. If you are coming into Clifton from the east on Highway 9 DO NOT follow 9 by turning north at the school; continue on west 5 blocks to the corner of Bridge and Parallel streets. If you have trouble or cannot understand these directions, call or email me and I'll help you.

We will start at 1:00 with the meal; the awards will follow. You have the choice of a brisket or BBQ chicken dinner. These include a tossed salad, baked potato, roll and tea or coffee. The cost is \$8.50 for the brisket and \$9.00 for the chicken. We also have a chicken strip basket (chicken strips and fries) at a cost of \$6.50 for the kids. If you have smaller kids and want to get one for them to share, that's ok too.

IMPORTANT: I need everyone who plans to eat to RSVP me with numbers and what they would like to eat by February 15th.

Remember, you must be present or designate a representative to pick up your prize(s) if you cannot make it to the banquet/meeting.

The following are KS05 district rules, please read carefully:

- 1) You can only win one first or second place award per class. If you win two first or second place awards in one class you will trade awards with the next place and on down through the places. The first place award will still say "Champion" and the second place award will say "Reserve Champion". You can win two first or second place awards only if you compete in Open and Youth or Open and Senior classes.

- 2) Members must participate in Open, Youth or Senior classes a minimum of 6 times (in each class) to receive year-end awards in the respective classes. This rule will be waived for new members joining on or after the date of the 7th show.
- 3) All advertising sold in 2008 will expire with the December 2008 newsletter.
- 4) Members selling \$50 or more in advertising for the newsletter will be exempted from paying the \$5/show awards fee.
- 5) Members must be present or have a delegate to pick up year-end awards at the Banquet or they will be used for another purpose.
