SHOW BILL REMINDERS

KSHA people are busy people. Planning for shows around work schedules & other family activities is tricky sometimes. Having adequate advance notice to upcoming show bills is very, very helpful!!! So, show managers, we appreciate all your efforts to put on a show & remind you of the following KSHA show bill rules.

Seven weeks prior to show: Application, fees, & hardcopy show bill due for KSHA approval; show bill will be returned with suggestions in 30 days.

Three weeks prior to show: Show bills must be mailed to ALL KSHA members.

Encourage show managers to stick to these rules & no one will be frustrated.

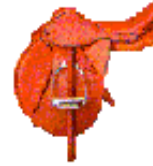
