Show deadlines:

Seven weeks prior to show: Application, fees, and hardcopy showbill due for KSHA approval; showbill will be returned with suggestions in 30 days

Three weeks prior to show: Showbills must be mailed to ALL KSHA members

Penalties: Shows that fail to meet the above deadlines or who do not agree to 100% compliance with the checklist may be levied a **\$100 fine** per show and are at risk of not receiving KSHA approval.

KSHA Horse Show Checklist:

Facility Standards

- Minimum Ring size of 60' X 110'
- Safe, reasonably level footing that is no more than 4" deep
- Adequate parking to accommodate large trailers, even in wet conditions
- Must be prepared to water down a dry ring for dust control and/or work up any wet areas for more uniform conditions.
- Concession stand
- Bleachers
- Telephone
- Accessible, clean, and stocked restrooms
- Working and easily accessible spigot
- a PA system that can be heard through out the grounds

Conduct of shows

- Must have a designated show person, and phone number listed, who is easily accessible prior to show date for questions that might arise.
- Application, fees, and showbill must be submitted between 6 months to no later than 7 weeks prior to show date to KSHA show coordinator. **NO SHOW WILL BE APPROVED FOR POINTS UNTIL THE SHOWBILL HAS BEEN APPROVED!**
- Showbills must be mailed to all KSHA members at least 3 weeks prior to show
- All KSHA members must be notified in writing of changes to your showbill 10 days prior to the show for that class to count for points
- Each show shall appoint a "ring committee" to enforce **KSHA** rules and to maintain a safe environment for all horses and exhibitors. This committee should also be prepared to ensure the humane treatment of all animals on the showgrounds.
- Each show must have a qualified announcer and a competent and duly instructed ring steward
- Each show is required to have a veterinarian and a farrier on call
- A paddock judge/steward is recommended to check attire and tack prior to the classes. The gatekeeper may fulfill this role.
- Judges evaluation cards must be available to exhibitors at the horse show office
- Shows must provide results to the KSHA Show Chairperson within 30 days of the close of your show
