Name of Project: Proposed PUJ, Tricycle and Pedicab Assessment Office

Brief Description of Works: Construction of the PUJ, Tricycle and Pedicab Assessment Office at the Ground Floor of Caloocan City Hall

1. The City of Caloocan, through the *General Fund of the 2006 Annual Budget of the City as per Sanguniang Panlungsod Ordinance No. 1102 s. 2005* intends to apply the sum of *One Million Four Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Six and 01/100 Pesos (P 1,494,486.01)* being the Approved Budget for Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the *Proposed PUJ, Tricycle and Pedicab Assessment Office*. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.
2. The City of Caloocan now calls for the submission of Letters of Intent (LOIs) from potential Bidders to apply for eligibility for the *Construction of the PUJ, Tricycle and Pedicab Assessment Office at the Ground Floor of Caloocan City Hall*. Bidders should possess a valid PCAB license applicable to the above type and cost of the contract, have completed a similar contract with a value of at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, and meet the other minimum eligibility requirements stated in the Eligibility Documents. Interested Bidders must submit their LOIs on or before *November 30, 2006 at 5:00 pm* at the *BAC Secretariat, Office of the Bids and Awards Committee, 2nd Floor, Caloocan City Hall, A. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act," and is restricted, unless otherwise stated, to organizations with at least seventy-five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines. In accordance with the IRR-A of R.A. 9184, only Bids from eligible Bidders will be opened. In accordance with the IRR-A of R.A. 9184 a contract will only be awarded to the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder who was determined as such during post-qualification.
