Election of officers - The first order of business was to select this year's officers. 2005-06 President Deborah Hiltzik and Treasurer Karen Farren have served the maximum 2 years under the current by-laws, but are willing to continue if no one else volunteers. Before the vote, brief job descriptions were outlined as follows: President – undertakes planning, publicity & ticket sales for Class Notes fundraiser; planning & organizing for festivals, especially Reno. Most of the time required is early in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, and also in Aug.

Treasurer – collects money and handles financial statements.

Secretary - keeps minutes at meetings.

There were no new nominations for either President or Treasurer. Club by-laws were amended to extend the term of officers to up to 3 years. The office of Vice-President/President Pro Tem was created to share the responsibilities and to ease the transitions between presidents.

2006-07 officers were elected: President - Deborah Hiltzik; Treasurer - Karen Farren; Secretary - Donna Chinn.

Audit Report – Hugh MacInnes presented the internal audit for fiscal year 2005-06, which shows a balance of approx. \$16K. Report was accepted.

Treasurer's Report - Karen Farren presented the projected budget for 2006-07 and the income statement & balance sheet. The budget was approved. Karen also explained that Booster Club is a non-profit organization, which is still in its probationary period. Booster Club does offer 1 or 2 partial scholarships, based on economic need and Board approval. See Karen for application.

Director's Notes - John Rush expressed praise for both Jazz Bands and optimism for the coming year. He reviewed the calendar; some dates are not yet firm. Tentative dates are: Winter Concert on 12/20; Disneyland on either 2/12 or 19; Class Notes on 3/10; All District Band on 3/6; Fullerton Jazz Festival on 3/24; Reno on 4/26-29; San Clemente Festival on 5/12; Brea-Olinda Festival on 5/19; Band Banquet on 6/3 or 10; Spring Concert on 6/12.
