**Recipe of the month:** Broken Glass. 1 1/3 cups of sugar, 2 cups light corn syrup, 1 cup water. 1 teaspoon cinnamon flavoring oil, 1/4 teaspoon red food coloring. Mix 1st 3 ingredients together in a large sauce pan. Stir together over medium heat until temperature reaches 310 degrees. Remove from heat and stir in flavor and coloring. Pour onto well greased sheet pan and let cool. Break with spoon.
