Lark Ellen Lions Charities is sponsored by the Los Angeles Host Lions Club, and you as a club member are automatically a member of this youth-oriented charity foundation. The directors of Lark Ellen are elected by and from the members of the Los Angeles Host Lions Club.

From March 1, 1977 through February 29, 2008, donations totaling \$1,077,647 have been made by Lark Ellen to youth-serving organizations in our community. During the past fiscal year, we distributed \$59,000 in donations to 15 organizations:

In the June issue new member David M. Bermudez described family background, growing up, education. Let's listen to him as he continues describing how he helped make Echo Park a better place in which to live: "I grew up in a household where my parents were adamant about cleanliness around our home and street. As a community activist I began fighting the battle against graffiti along with many of my neighbors. We were the original 'Graffiti Busters.' Soon we formed the Silver Lake Improvement Association which began to address the blight in the neighborhood, including graffiti, trash, drug dealing, and the gang presence. Approximately fourteen years ago I was introduced to and employed by Central City Action Committee, the Echo Park based youth program. They were beginning to receive funding for graffiti abatement in the immediate area. As they say, the rest is history. Over these many years, CCAC and I have - unbelievably - been abating graffiti in the Metropolitan Los Angeles area." - to be concluded
